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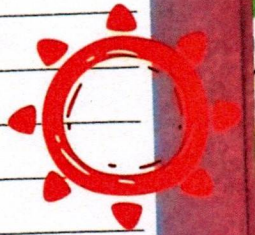

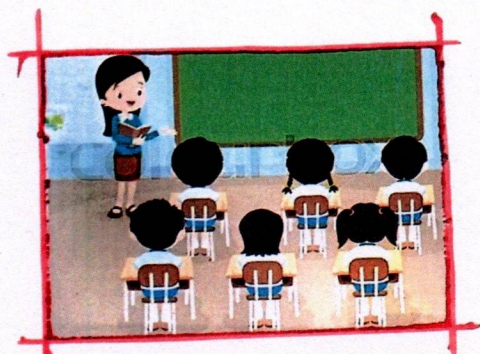

Types of observation schedule :

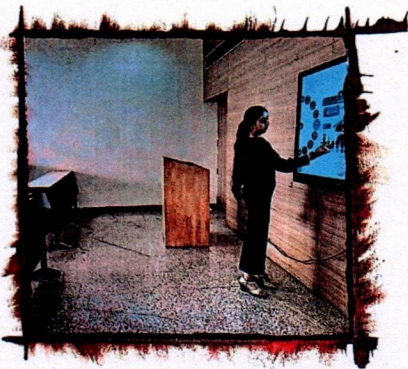
1. Participant observation

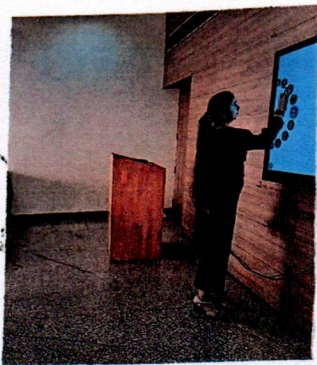
