




Photo 1: Commencement of Alumni Talk




Photo 3: Ms. Aishwarya Seth Likhyani beginning the session




Photo 4: Ms. Aishwarya Seth Likhyani discussing the various career paths




Photo 5: Ms. Aishwarya Seth Likhyani discussing the various career paths




Figure 2 Audience addressed by Dr. Kaushal Kumar










