## POLICY ON ALUMNI MENTORING SYSTEM

#### 1. Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to establish a structured Alumni Mentoring System at K.R. Mangalam University that fosters meaningful connections between alumni and current students. The system aims to support students in their academic journey, professional growth, and personal development by leveraging the experience and networks of the university's alumni.

#### 2. Objectives

- To enable students to benefit from the professional experience and insights of alumni
- To promote career readiness, entrepreneurship, research exposure, and higher education planning
- To develop leadership, communication, and interpersonal skills among mentees
- To strengthen alumni engagement and their bond with the university
- To build a sustainable mentoring culture within the university ecosystem

#### 3. Scope

This policy is applicable to:

- All registered alumni of K.R. Mangalam University
- · All current students of undergraduate, postgraduate, and doctoral programmes
- The Office of Alumni Relations, Training and Placement Cell, and respective School Deans and office of the Dean Students Welfare.

## 4. Structure of the Alumni Mentoring System

#### 4.1 Types of Mentoring

#### 4.2 Format of Engagement

- One-on-one mentoring (student-alumnus pairing)
- Group mentoring (one alumnus to a small group of students)

#### 5. Roles and Responsibilities

#### 5.1 Office of Alumni Relations

- Monitor progress and collect feedback
- Issue letters of appreciation/certificates to mentors and mentees

- Offer guidance within professional and ethical limits
- Maintain confidentiality and professionalism
- Submit brief mentoring reports (if required)

#### 5.3 Mentees (Students)

- Be respectful of the mentor's time and expertise
- Attend sessions regularly and prepare adequately
- Be open to feedback and maintain confidentiality
- Submit feedback post-mentoring cycle

#### 6. Eligibility Criteria

#### 6.1 For Mentors (Alumni)

- Must be a graduate/postgraduate/research alumnus of KRMU
- Minimum 2 years of professional or academic experience
- Voluntary registration and consent to mentor

#### 6.2 For Mentees (Students)

- Must be enrolled in full-time degree programmes
- Should apply through the respective School or Office of Alumni Relations

#### 7. Registration and Onboarding Process

#### 7.1 Alumni Mentor Registration

- Office of Alumni Relations verifies and shortlists mentors
- Issue Letter of Engagement to selected alumni mentors








