



### Introduction:

With an objective to build strong alumni connections with the existing student-teachers of the School of Education and help them learn from their success stories, Alumni Tal was organized with Ms. Nisha Nautiyal, Alumna, B.El.Ed. (Batch 2018-22). During the session, she discussed Central Teachers' Eligibility Test (CTET) and how student teachers can prepare for the exam.

### Objectives:

- 1. To acquaint the student-teachers with the background of CTET, and basic requirements to appear for CTET.
- 2. To discuss the importance of the CTET exam in their employment.
- 3. To acquaint the student-teachers of the strategies which they can adopt to crack the CTET and other Teachers'" Eligibility Exams (TETs).

The session started at 12:00 PM with a welcome to the speaker of the day, Ms. Nisha Nautiyal and then a brief introduction about the purpose of today's session. Ms. Nisha deliberated upon several aspects during her presentation and interaction with the student-teachers (Picture 1). She began the interaction by discussing the theme, CTET, what it is and what all educational qualifications a candidate should have in order to appear for the exam (Picture 2). Further, she discussed the availability of the forms and advised the student-teachers to remain updated by regularly checking the CTET website. She then deliberated upon the types of questions that come in the exam and the themes from which these questions are asked. During the second part of her presentation, she discussed how did she prepare for her exam and how was her journey (Picture 3). She discussed that attending all the classes regularly is an essential aspect to get familiar with the concepts. Besides, she also discussed how much time a candidate must devote daily to appear for the same. She mentioned several reference books which a candidate can consult to prepare for the examination. The student-teachers asked several questions from her and cleared their doubts. Towards the end of the session, Ms. Jeevanshi, Ms. Mokshita and Ms. Arushi (student-teachers from B.El.Ed.) shared their experiences and thanked the speaker of the day (Picture 4). A formal vote of thanks was given by Prof. Tania Gupta (Dean, SOED) to Ms. Nisha (Picture 5).


Activity Outcome: The student-teachers developed an understanding of the importance of CTET for their successful employment and how they can prepare for the same while being in their regular teacher educator courses. They learnt how they can prepare for their exam, and all books they can consult so that they can get success in the CTET exam.

Conclusion: The session was highly informative for the student-teachers of SOED and they got quite a good exposure to how they can strategize their studies so that they can crack the CTET exam early in their careers.



<u>Picture 1: Alumina Ms. Nisha Nautiyal intercating with the student-teachers of SOED</u>




Picture 2: Ms. Nisha discussing about the eligibility criteria to apply for CTET exam


