#### 2. Day-wise Report of the Sessions Conducted

Monday 20th Feb. 2023

The first technical session was on the topic Simulation and Role Playing in imparting Operational and management knowledge skills and the guest speaker was Ms. Poulomi Bhattachary a, Director- Talent and Culture, Accor group. 

He shared the data that COVID-19's economic toll on the restaurant industry hasn't been evenly distributed. Whereas pizza chains have maintained or increased sales during the pandemic, casual-dining and fine-dining restaurants have seen their revenues decline by as much as 85 percent. He also discussed possible solutions and rebounding strategies by restaurant Industry.


