The session was attended by 324 participants from across the nation.

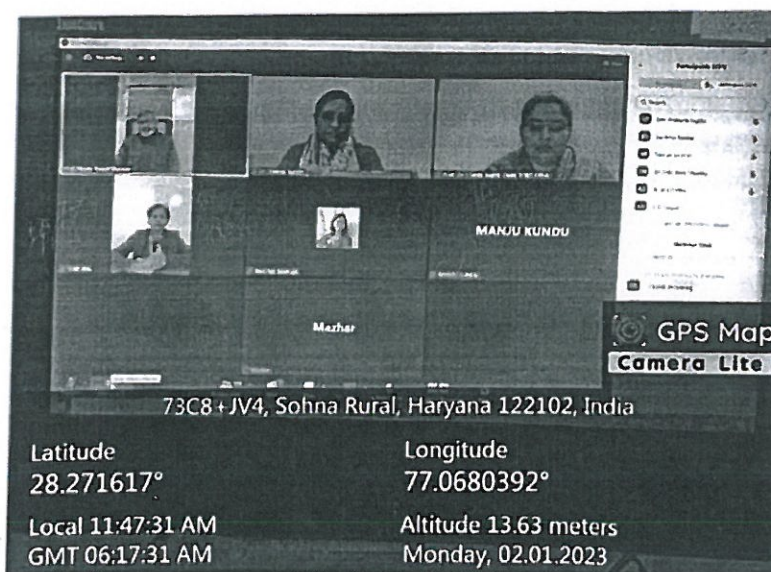

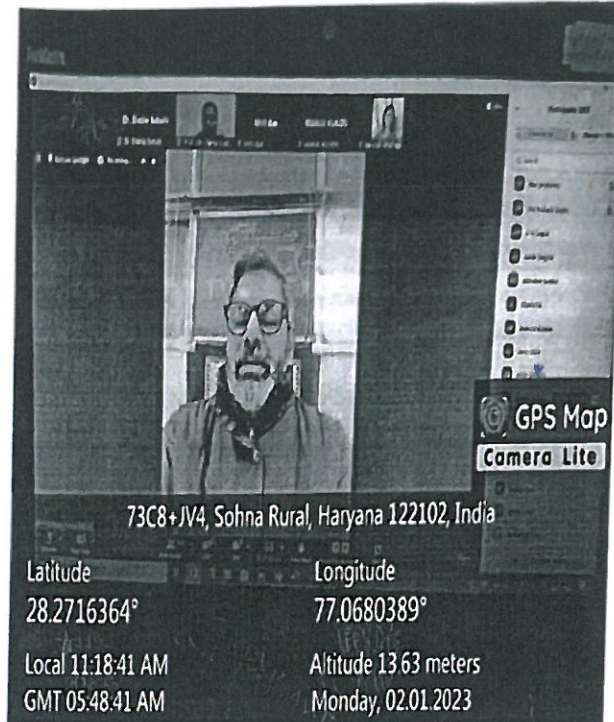


Photo 2: Photo of Guest Speaker

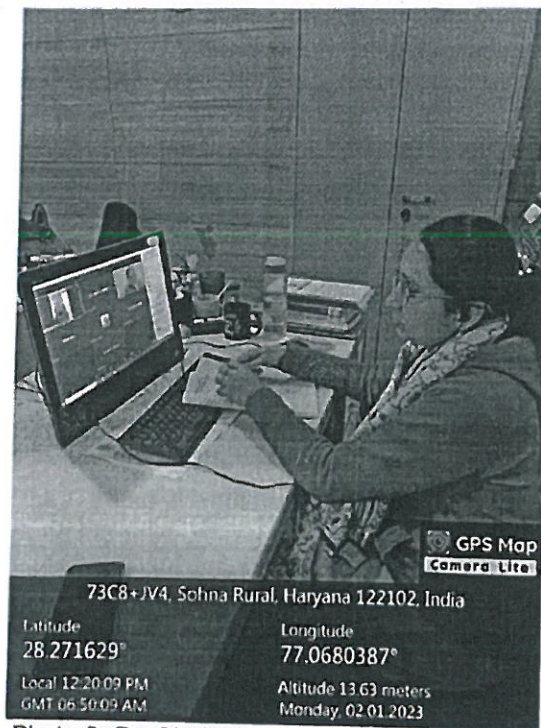


Photo 3: Dr. Shabia Subuhi at Welcome Session

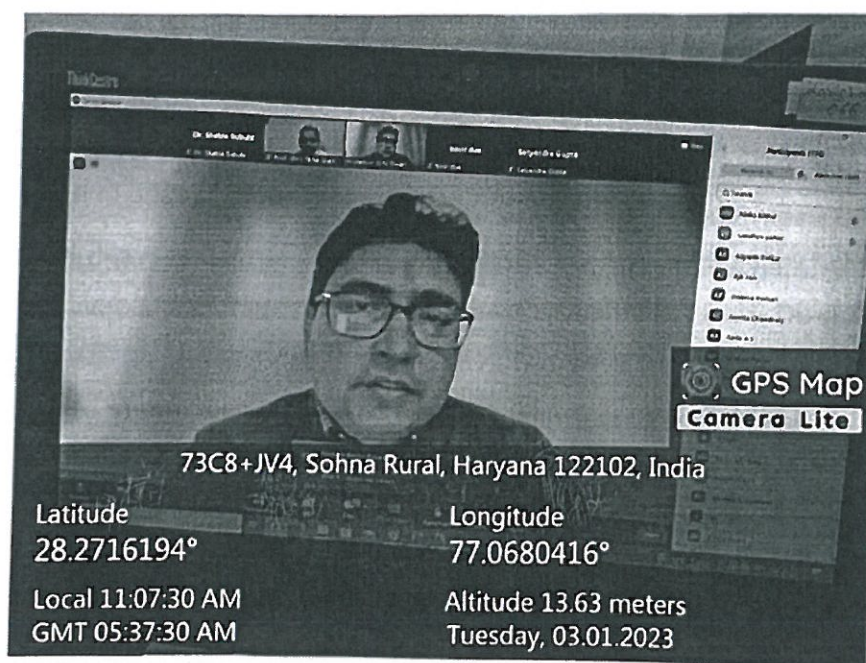

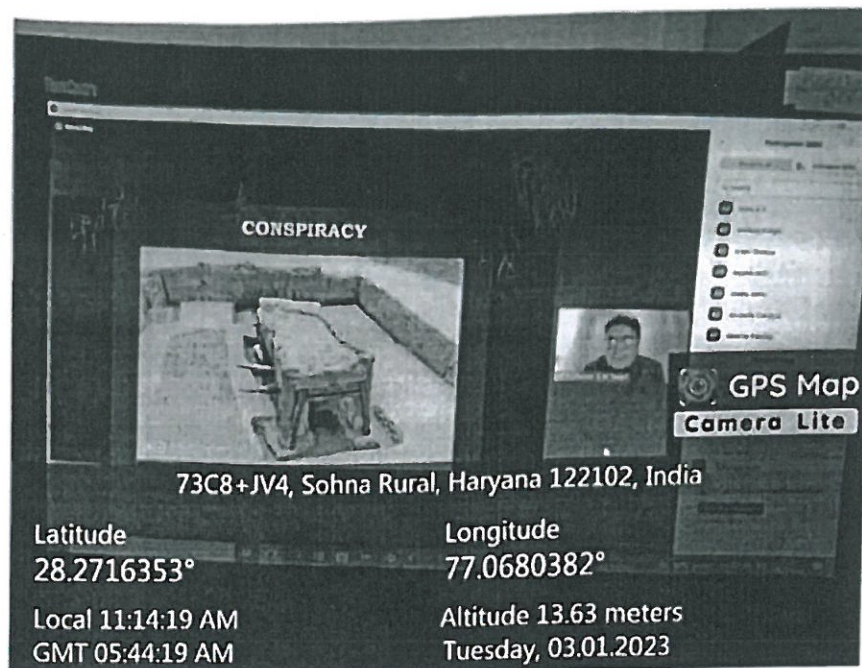


Photo 5: Guest speaker while Presenting

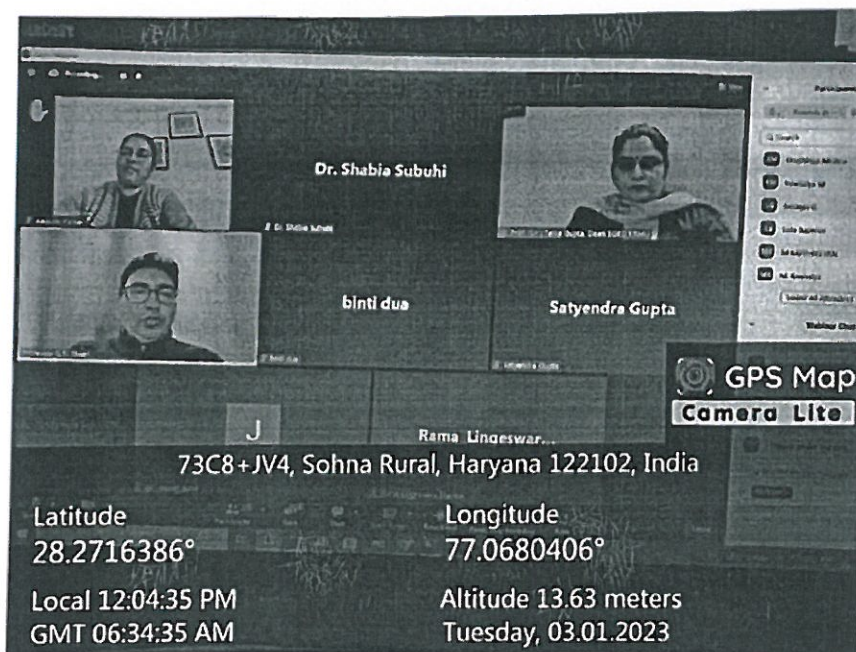

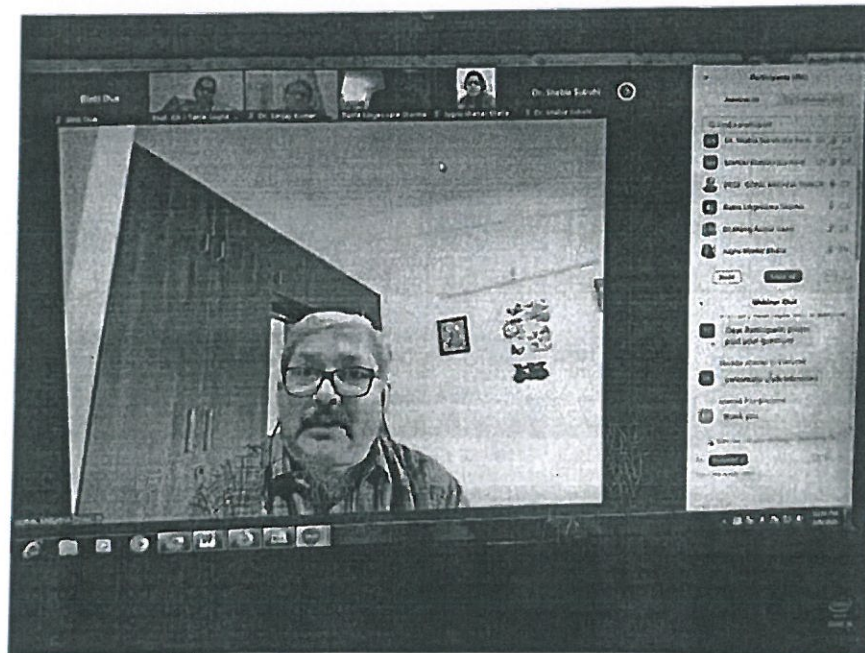
