She is cancer survivor and has founded 'Well We Live' – an initiative that works towards inspiring people with a mission they have named as Ayushmaan bhava which follows with the spirit of Conquerorship beyond just survivorship of diseases or any other traumatic life events. and Ms. Krishna (Asha worker). In the program, almost 40 participants including K R Mangalam University students and villagers were present. The main objective of the program was to raise the awareness among the women's health regarding cancer and to provide insight into managing their health better.

The event was started by Dr. Pooja Vats, Coordinator of the event by giving brief introduction about the Dr. Richa Agarwal.

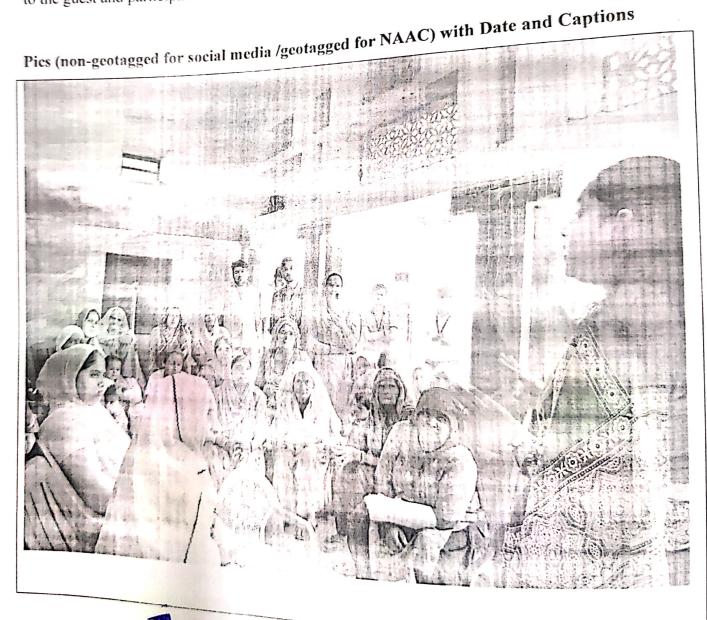

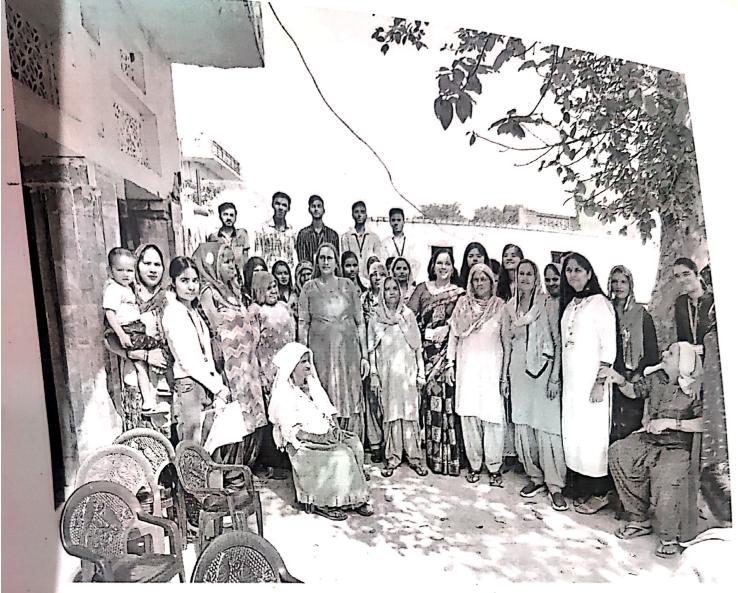
