School of Legal Studies conducted Awareness Drive about the Start-Up India Scheme for the residents of village Raisika, Roz Ka Meo. Start-up India initiative was launched in January 2016 with the objective to provide a platform to start-up enterprises and potential entrepreneurs to be recognised and funded to make India a country of job creators. Keeping that in mind, the students of SOLS, KRMU made their best effort to impart the importance of generating viable business opportunities in rural areas and motivated the villagers, especially the youth that was present there to start their micro enterprises or businesses by availing the benefits the government is giving under the Start-Up India Scheme. Student Coordinator Mr. Akash Godara initiated the drive by briefing the villagers about the features, eligibility, process, and the benefits a business would get if registered under the scheme (Photo1). Further, Mr. Nischay Nath Tiwari informed the residents of village about the process

involved in registration of startups and also about the website where they can register their business (Photo 2). He informed the villages about the different requirements, including the documentation they would need for the same. To encourage them more they were told about the benefits they would be eligible to receive if became a Start-Up: the easier compliance and exit processes, fast legal support, fast tracking of patent applications and IPR application. reduced fees on patent registration, tax exemptions under Income Tax Act, 1961 and about the easy winding up of company where their capital will not stick. Student volunteers addressed the queries of each person and showed them complete process of registration through the online portal of 'Start-Up India'. The youth also reciprocated with different innovative ideas they had in their mind for businesses. Being an agricultural village, they had some interesting entrepreneurial ideas related to farm businesses. The event was concluded with the feedback form from the people which has covered the basic questions about the awareness drive (Annexure III). They gave a positive feedback for the workshop and invited the team of SOLS to come again to conduct more awareness programme in their village. Pamphlets were also distributed among them to disseminate more information (Annexure IV).


