### **Introduction**

To abide by the traffic rules is one of our primary duties. Children, especially teen agers after getting license should be aware of traffic rules along with the penalties on the violation of it. Taking this fact into consideration Legal Committee in School of Legal studies took initiative in organising awareness workshop for the students of 9th and 10th class of Government Senior Secondary School, Lakhuwas.

#### **Objective**

- 1. To aware the students about Traffic Rules to avoid violation of the rules, and accidents
- 2. To discuss how to get learner license and license, minimum age to get license, free passage, signals on the food, their understanding of zebra crossing.

#### Content

The session was categorically divided into three parts; First where student coordinator has built up the talk over importance of traffic rules, second some of the sections under Motor Vehicle Act, 1988 have been discussed, third few cases were shared where traffic violation culprit has been punished.

- 1. The students from second year shared traffic rules with school students. They discussed the sections of Motor Vehicle Δct,1988 in common parlance language.
- 2. Faculty Coordinators shared their valuable inputs with few illustrations and landmark judgements.
- 3. The students have also been informed about the court proceedings for the cases of traffic rules violation.

Eighteen students along with two faculty members went to the Government Senior Secondary School, village Lakhuwas on dated 24<sup>th</sup> August 2022. The students from the school were filled with joy and excitement to see the University students in their school.

The session was full with 50 students in one classroom. Volunteer students have pasted the poster and pictures related to traffic rules in the classroom with due permission of the principal. The wall banners, pictures and posters helped the school students to understand signs and signals of traffic rules more clearly.

The session was started with the brief introduction of workshop by the faculty members. (Photo 1)

Student Coordinators Nischay Nath Tiwari (BBA LLB, II year) and Akash Godara (BALLB,

III Year) delivered an interactive lecture presentation on the traffic rules. (Photo 2)

- 3. This session motivates and inspire students' teenagers about the importance of legal education to become a responsible citizen.
