Therefore, after promoting the cause for which we stood people also appreciated our efforts and we went on ahead to our next destination Gamroj Toll Plaza.

At Ghamroj toll Plaza we had a small meeting with the manger of the toll office and with due permission our posters were also advertized at the notice boards as well. After that we talked with the officials at duty and got the chance to hold our posters at the toll gates without interrupting traffic to spread awareness about our cause 'Say No to Drugs; Say Yes to Life".

Students and faculty members of KRMU along with the villagers of Sohna and officials and travelers going through Toll Plaza


Activity Outcomes:






