School of Legal Studies had organised an Extension Activity under which a Workshop was organised in the Government School of Lakhuwas on the topic "Sensitizing Youth towards their basic legal rights." The idea behind this workshop was to impart awareness and sensitize the students about their basic legal rights. Awareness about the basic human and youth rights is very important as it is the legal consciousness that empowers individuals regarding issues involving infringement of their rights. Speakers for the event were Mr. Divyansh Chandel (BALLB IIIrd Sem) and Mr. Nischay Nath Tiwari(BBALLB IIIrd Sem). Mr. Divyansh commenced the workshop by briefing and introducing the students with the concept of basic legal rights and youth rights especially (Photol). He then told students about various

freedoms and rights which are available to them and are guaranteed by the constitution. Their freedom of Speech and Expression, along with the restrictions it comes, freedom to choose the career of their liking, freedom to profess any religion and worship any God in whichever way they want, their right to education, right to nutrition, and their Rights against Exploitation. They also discussed about human trafficking and exploitation of children. Students also participated by showing their keen interest towards their Right to Education and Child Labour, they wanted to know about their education & working rights, and when and where they can legally work if the situation demands so. They were made aware about the Child and Adolescent Labour Act, 1986 and the hazardous places they are prohibited to work in. The discussion was taken forward by Mr. Nischay towards the role of education in freedom and enforcement of these rights. Students were not only informed about their legal rights but also the responsibilities that come with it (Photo 2). Their age of marriage, voting, driving etc. were also discussed briefly along with important articles of the Indian Constitution. An interactive and student friendly questionnaire was also distributed at the end of the event to understand how much the students were able to gain from the workshop. (Annexure 3)

### The outcome of the event was:

- 1. At the end of the events students were well versed about their basic legal rights.
- 2. They learnt about their fundamental rights and legal responsibilities as the youth of this country.
