Students of SOMC (School of Management & Commerce) of first years joined this extension activity. Also 2 PhD Scholars who are currently pursuing their course work joined the session.

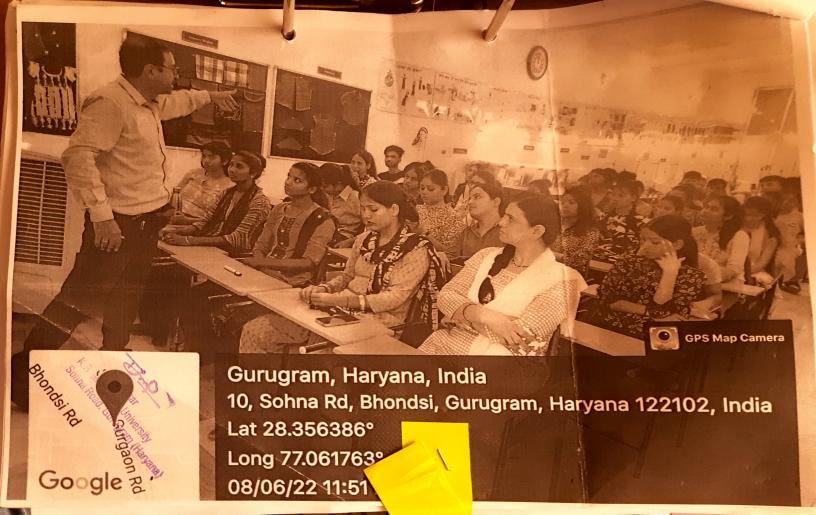

- Avail various Govt. entitlements and benefits under various socio-economic welfare schemes

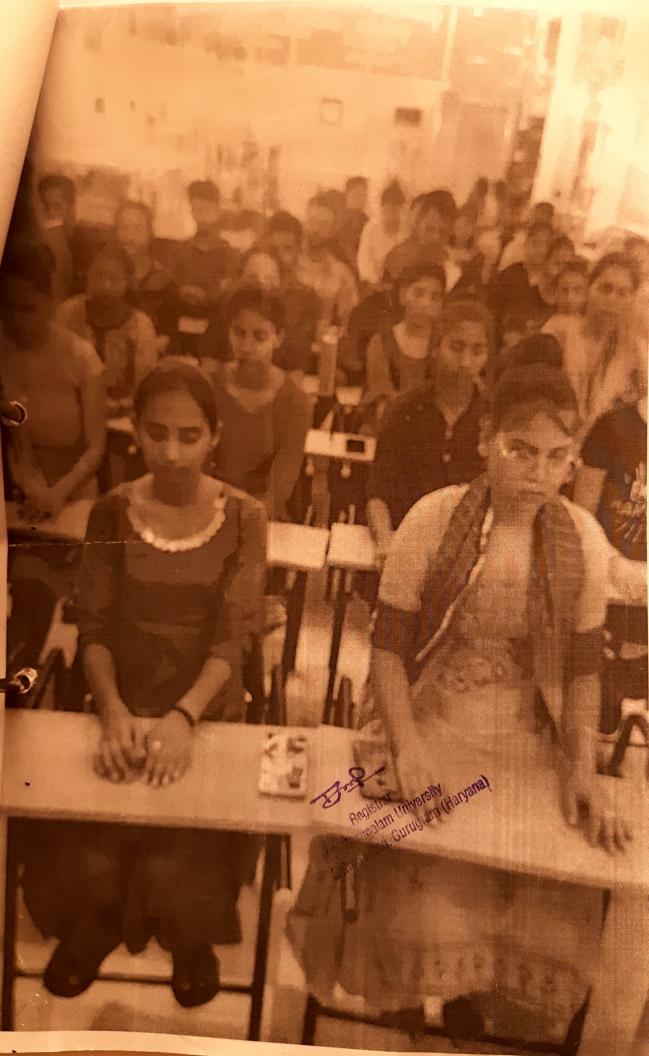

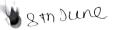
