The Participants prepared digital posters on the theme using various apps like canva, photoshop etc. The feedback link was shared with the participants to upload the digital poster.



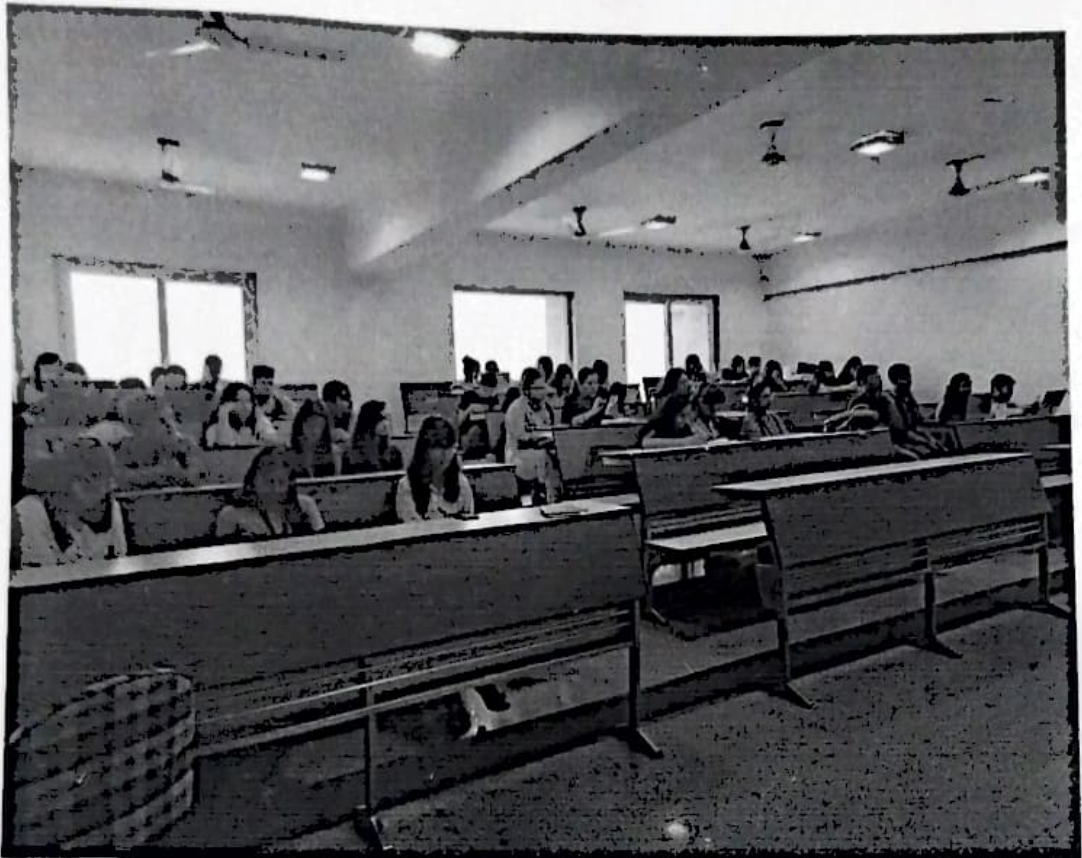


Photo1: Students participating in digital poster making competition on 16-09-2022



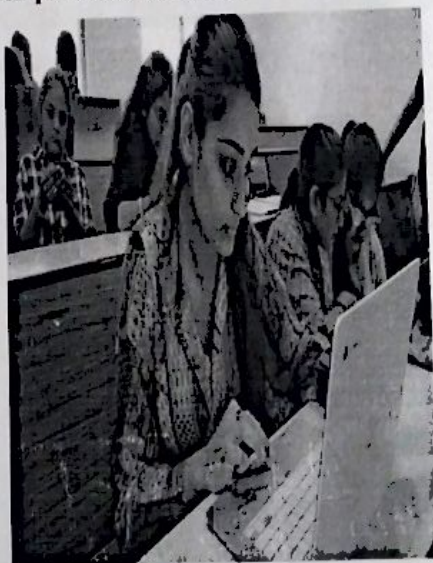

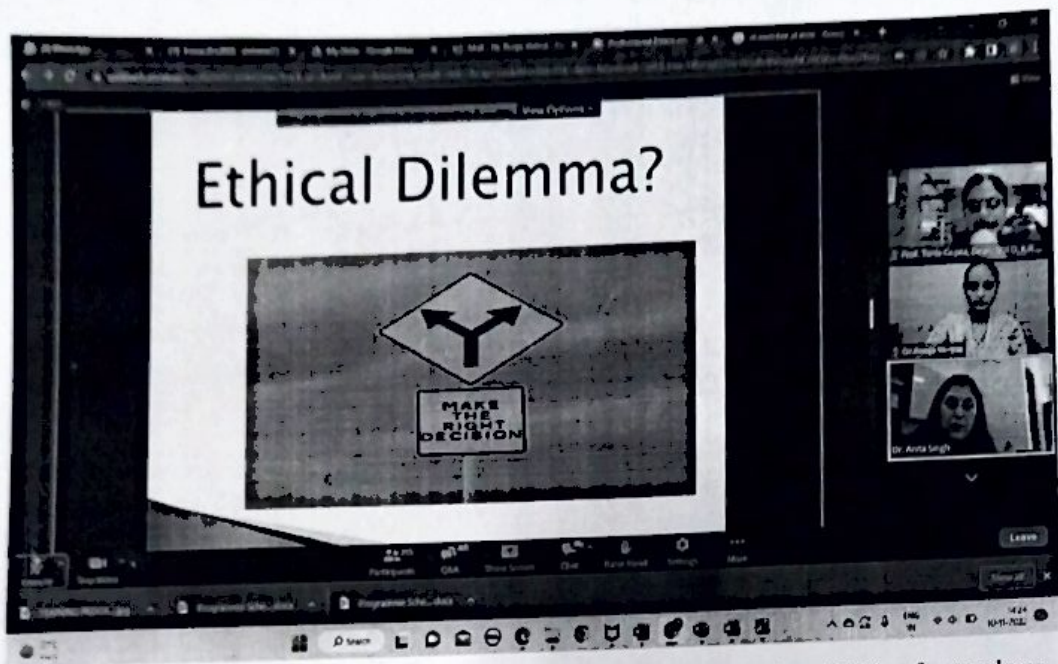


Photo 2: 10/11/2022-Dr.Anita Singh addressing the session on Professional Ethics for teachers.

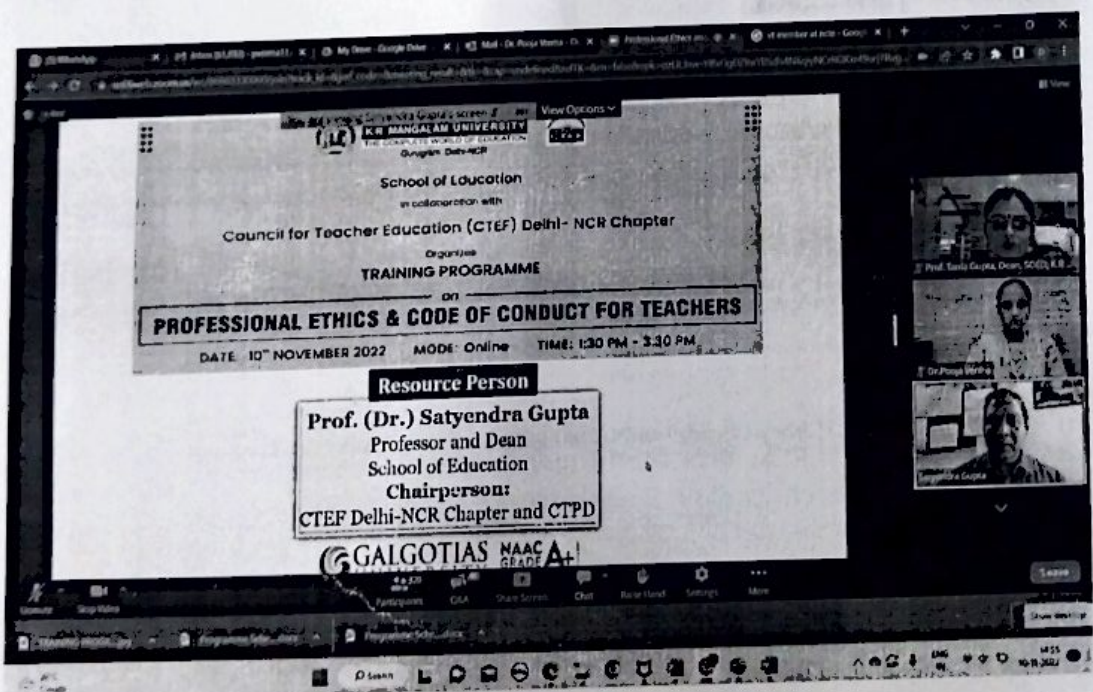


Photo 3: 10/11/2022- Prof. Satyendra Gupta starting his session on Code of Conduct for teachers

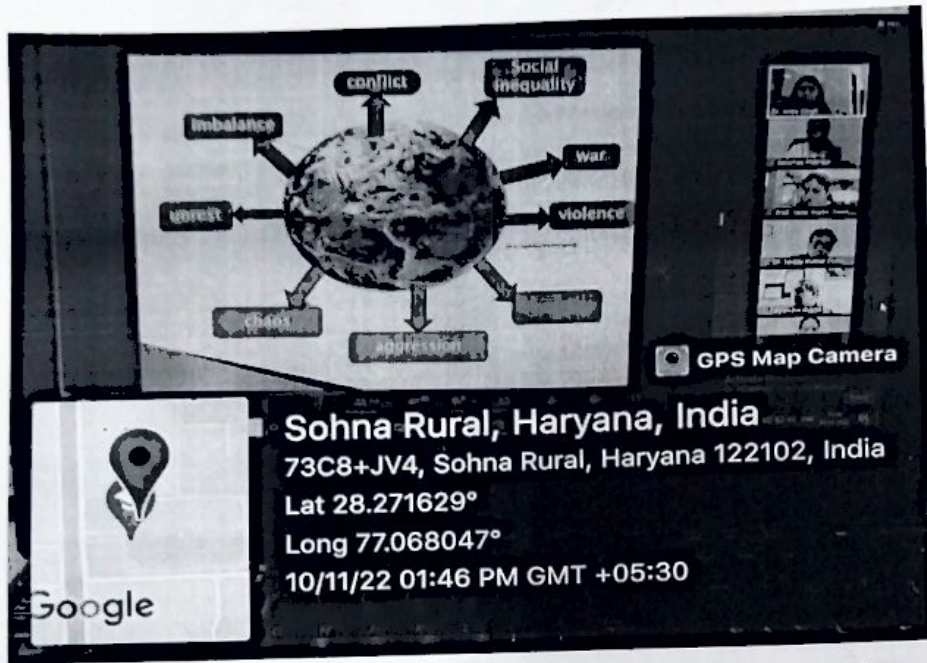


Photo 6: 10/11/2022-Dr.Anita Singh addressing the session on Professional Ethics for teachers.

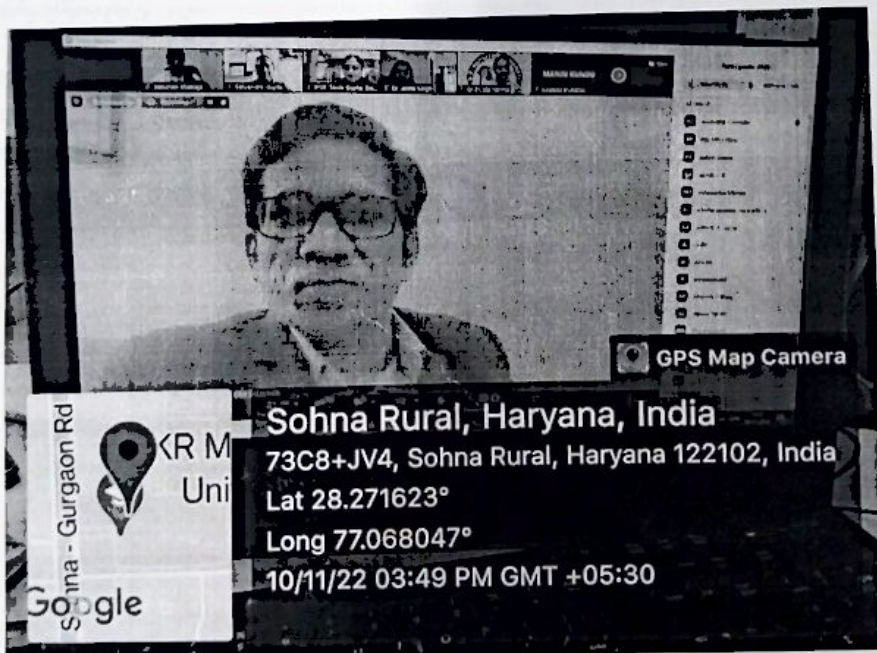

The session was attended by 324 participants from across the nation.

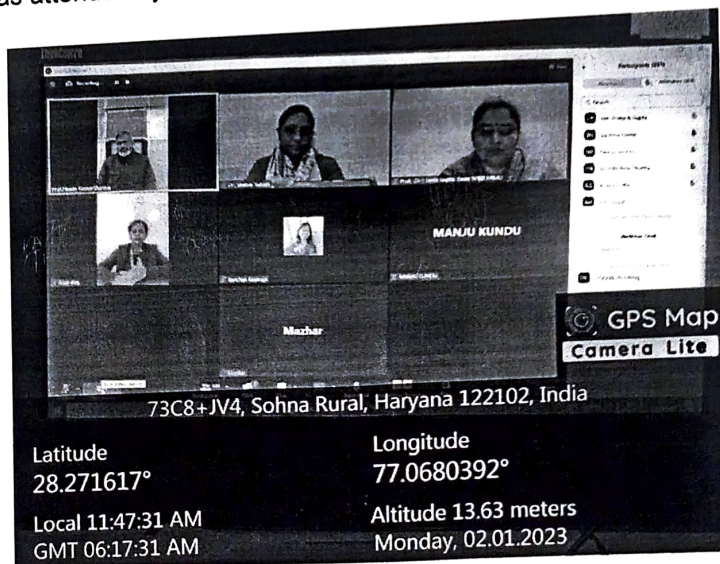

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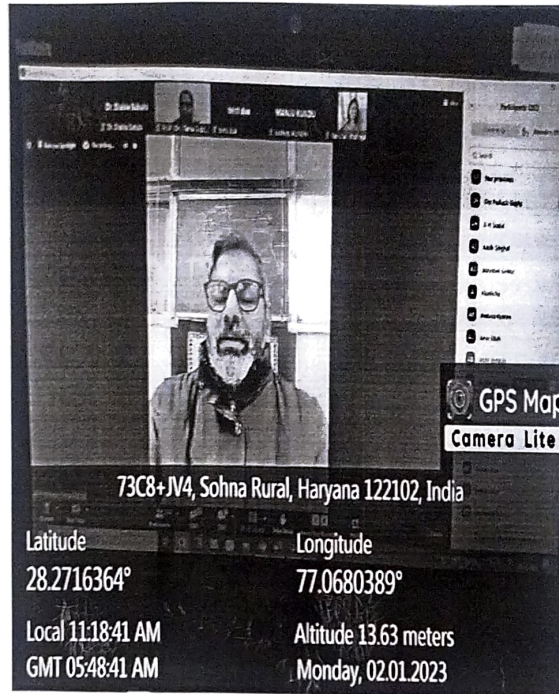


Photo 2: Photo of Guest Speaker

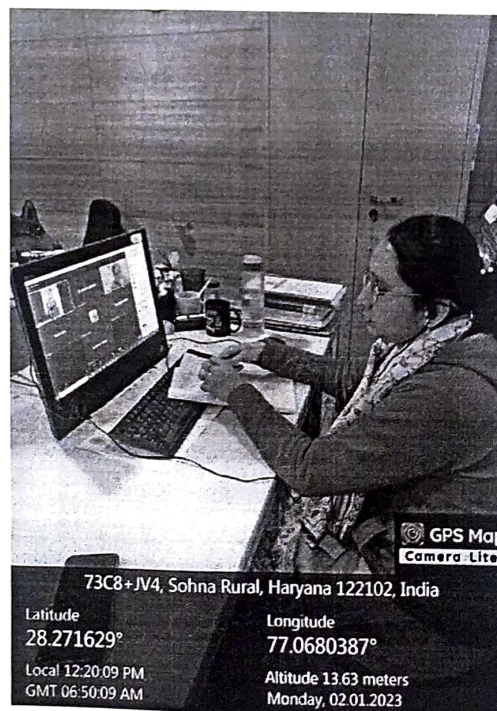


Photo 3: Dr. Shabia Subuhi at Welcome Session

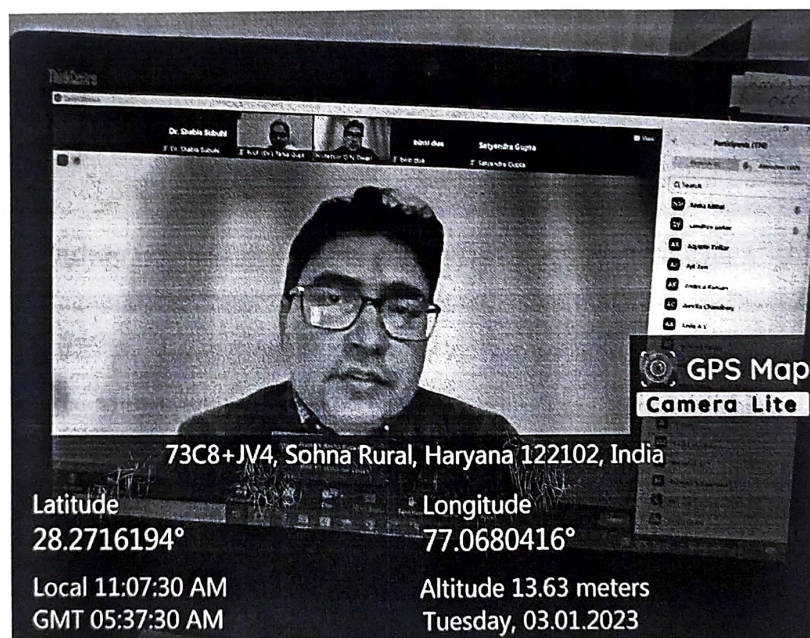

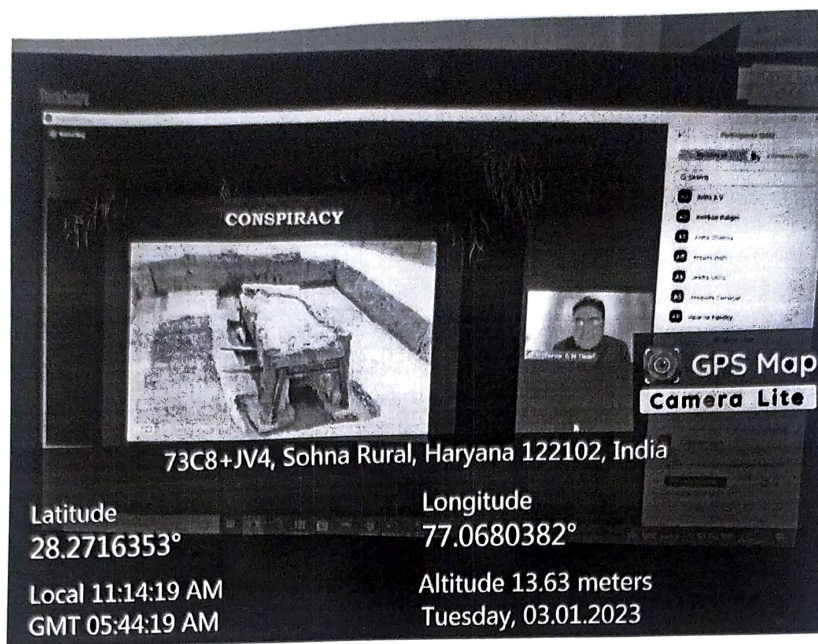


Photo 5: Guest speaker while Presenting

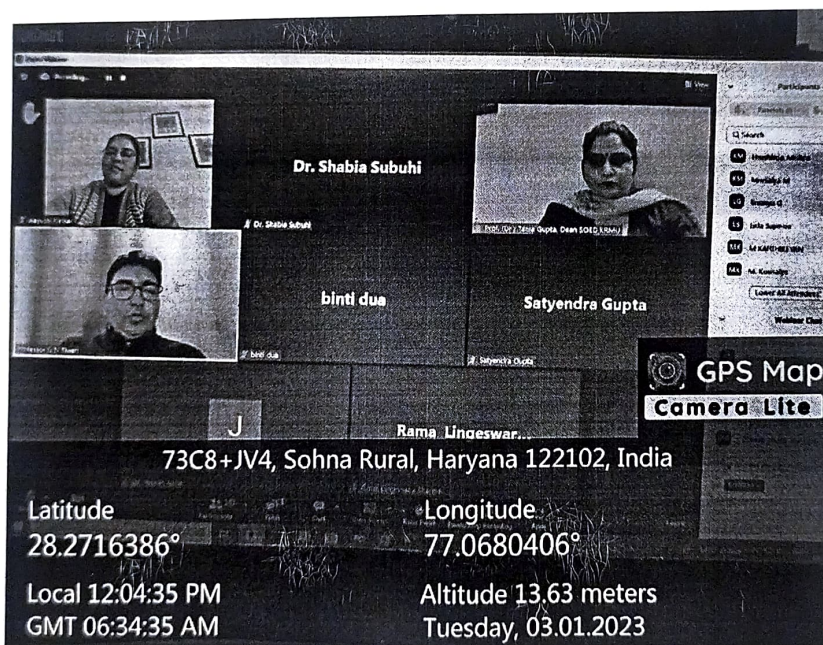

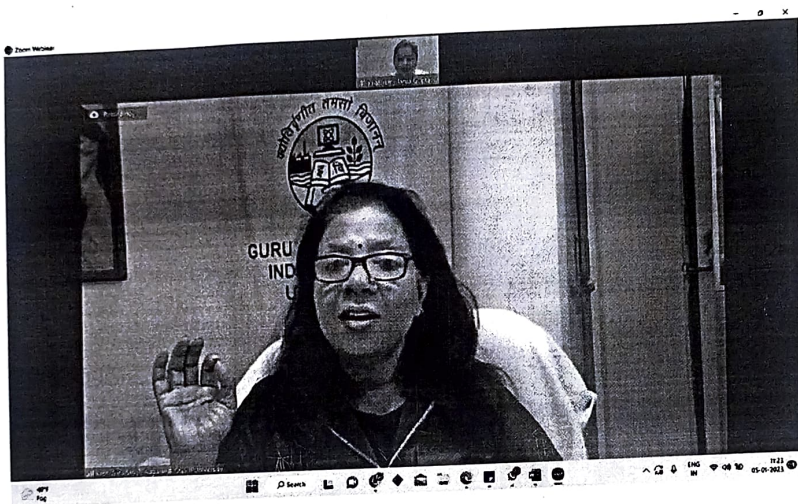






Photo: 11 Chief Guest during her Session





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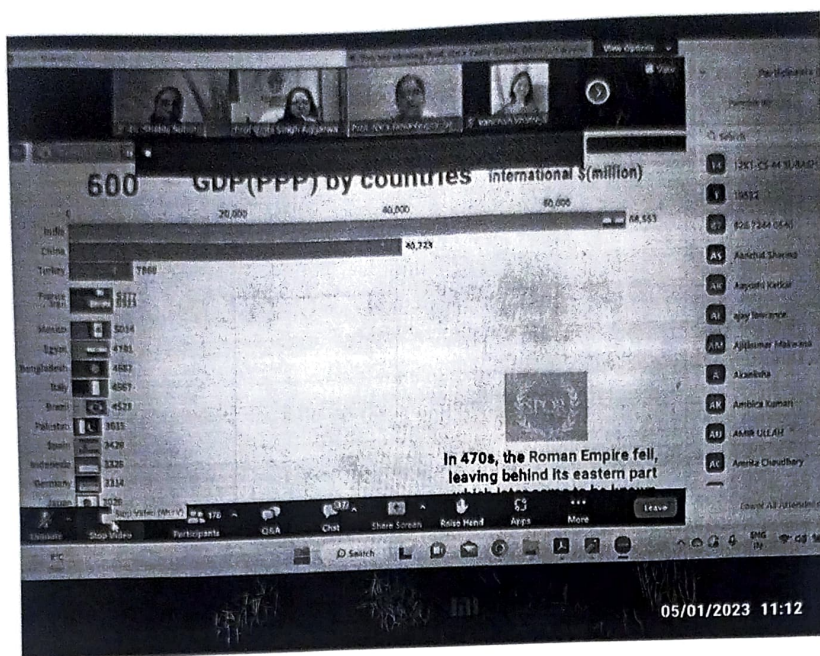

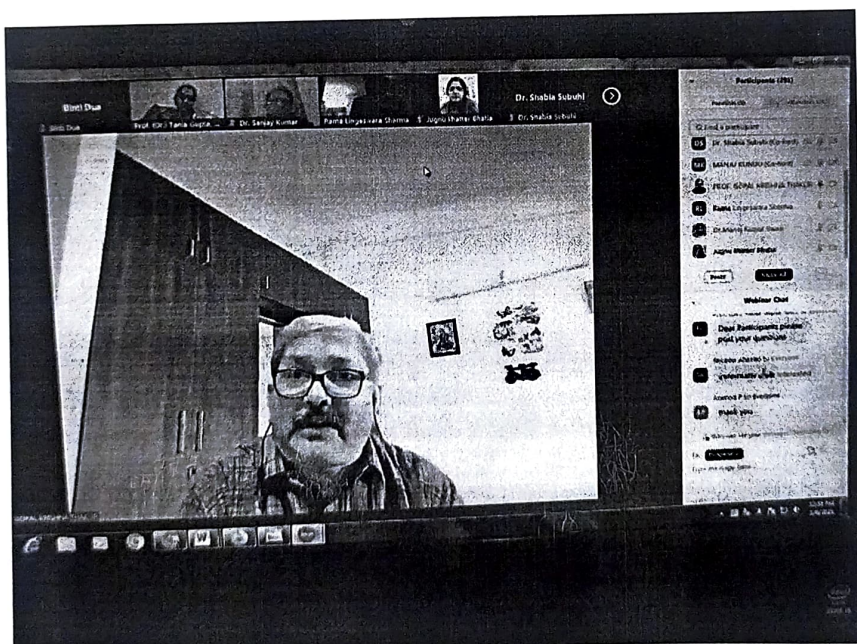

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SOED, K. R. Mangalam University delivered the Vote of Thanks. The session was attended by 275 enthusiastic participants from across the nation.

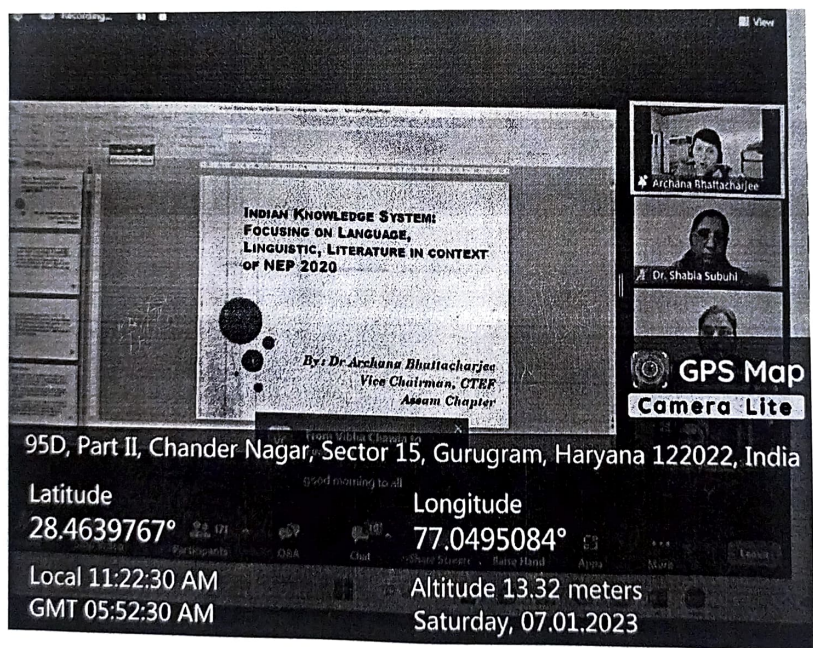


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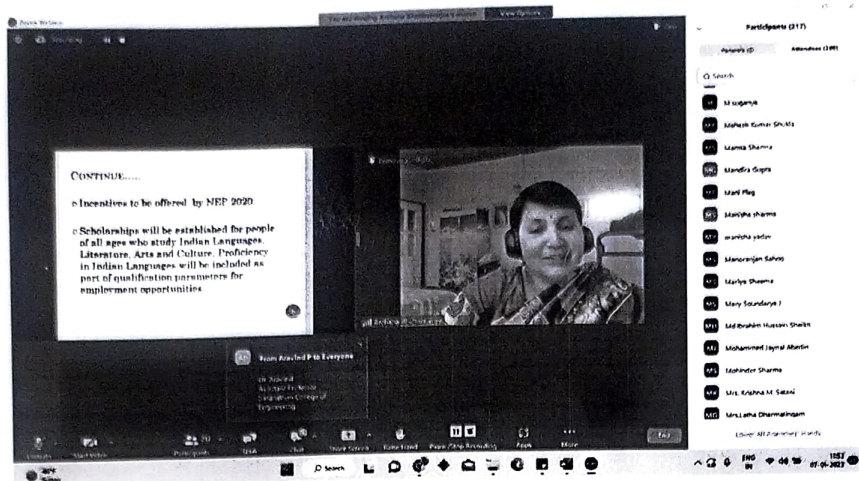


Photo 17: Q/A session with Chief Guest

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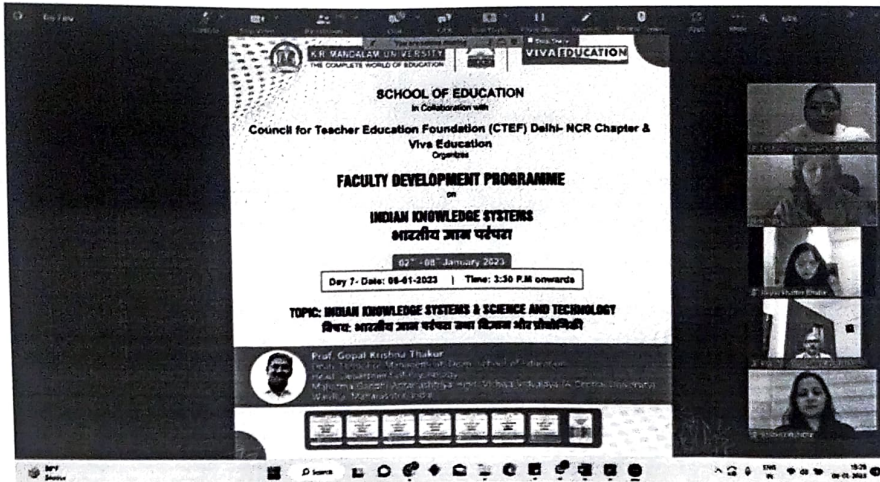


Photo 18 welcome address by Dr. Binti Dua

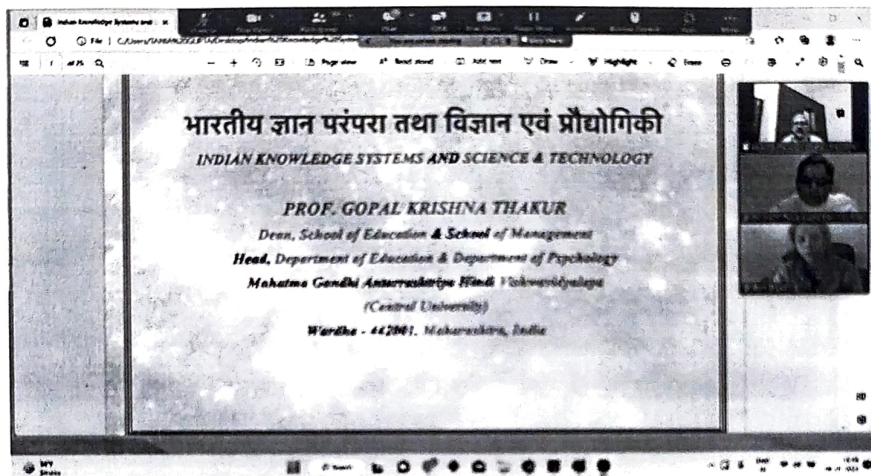


Photo 19 Session addressed by prof. Gopal Krishan Thakur
