Cultural, Educational and Scientific Cooperation Memorandum of Understanding Between

K.R. Mangalam University, Gurugram, Haryana, India
&
The Department of Architecture, University of Ferrara (DA_Unife), Italy

In accordance with a mutual desire to promote further cooperation K.R. Mangalam University, Gurugram, Haryana, India and the Department of Architecture at the University of Ferrara (DA_Unife) join in the following memorandum of understanding on cultural, educational and scientific cooperation.

Both institutes will encourage direct contact and cooperation between their faculty members, departments, institutes and other research centres subject to the provisions of this memorandum of understanding and will act as coordinators of contacts with other institutions as appropriate.

K.R. Mangalam University, Gurugram, Haryana, India and DA_Unife shall cooperate in fields of teaching and research to be agreed upon. Cooperation in further areas may be arranged by mutual understanding.

Both institutes agree to the following general forms of cooperation:

- Exchange of invitations to scholars for lectures, talks, and workshops.
- Exchange of invitations to scholars to participate in conferences, colloquia, symposia.
- Exchange of information in fields of interest to both institutions.
- Exchange of faculty members for study and research.
- Joint research activities.

Themes of joint activities and the conditions for utilizing the results achieved and arrangements for specific visits, exchanges and other forms of cooperation will be negotiated for each specific case.

Both institutions understand that all financial arrangements will have to be negotiated and will depend on the availability of funds.

This memorandum of understanding shall become effective after its signature by both parties, on the day of the last signature.

The memorandum of understanding shall be in force for a period of 2 years; thereafter, it may be renewed by mutual understanding. Either institute has the right to terminate the memorandum of understanding without cause, by providing notice in writing, a minimum of six months in advance.

This memorandum of understanding is drawn up in the English language.

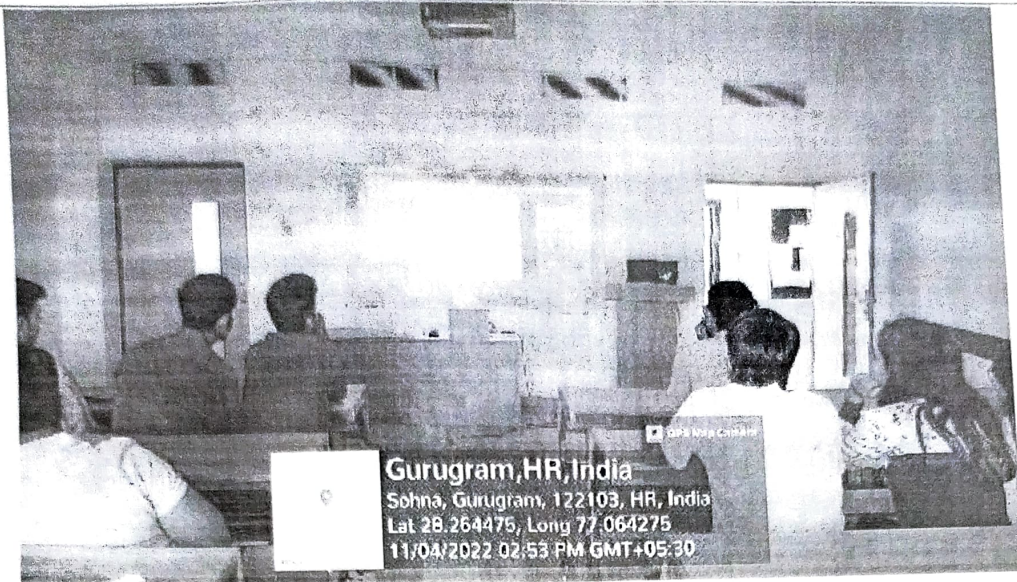


Fig 1 : Lecture Room 208 Attending Event

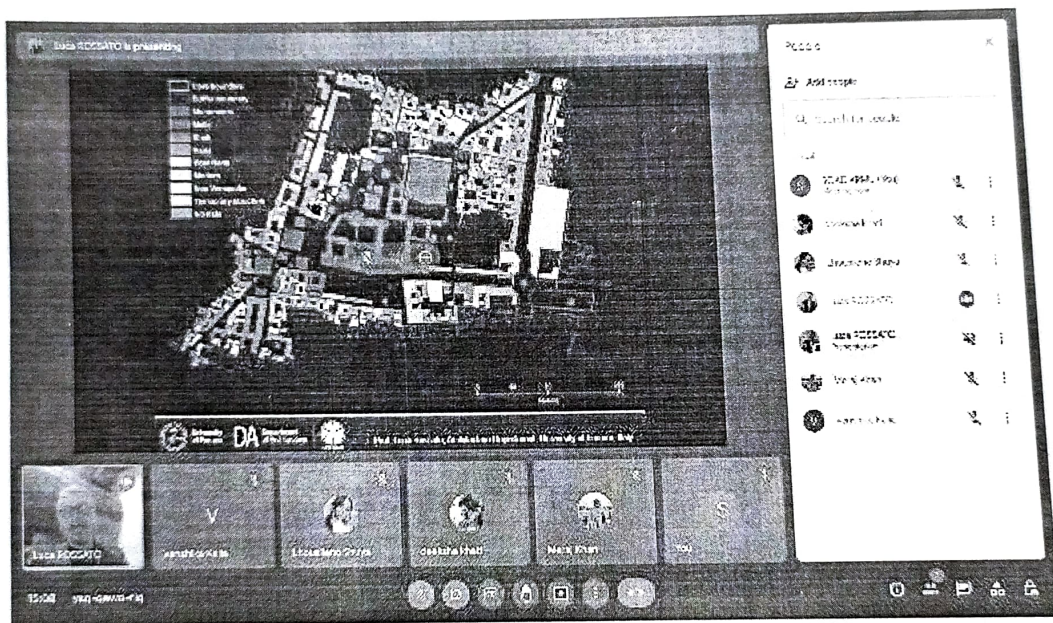


Fig 2 : Map Showing Different Zones

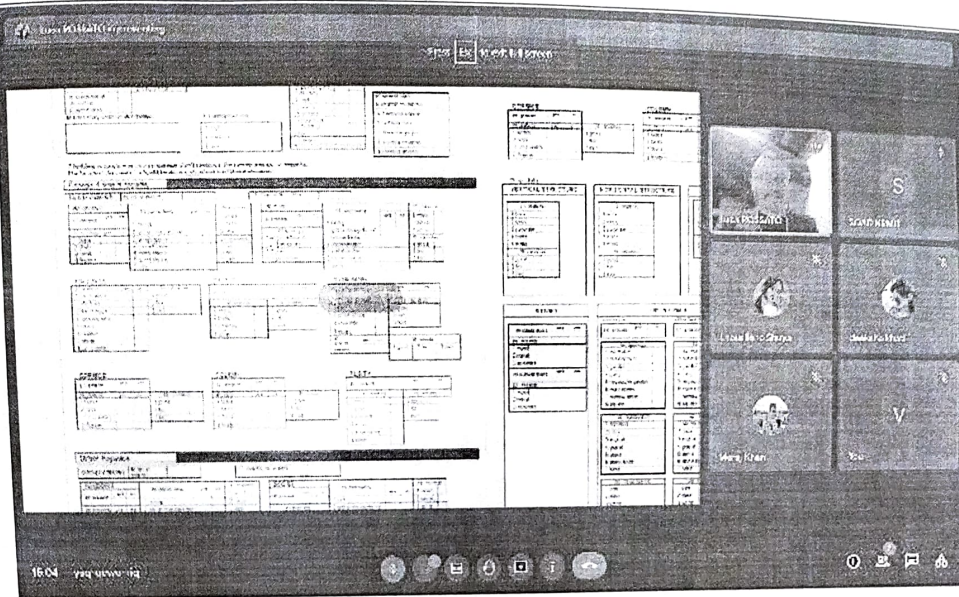


Fig 3 : Questionnaire Survey Table

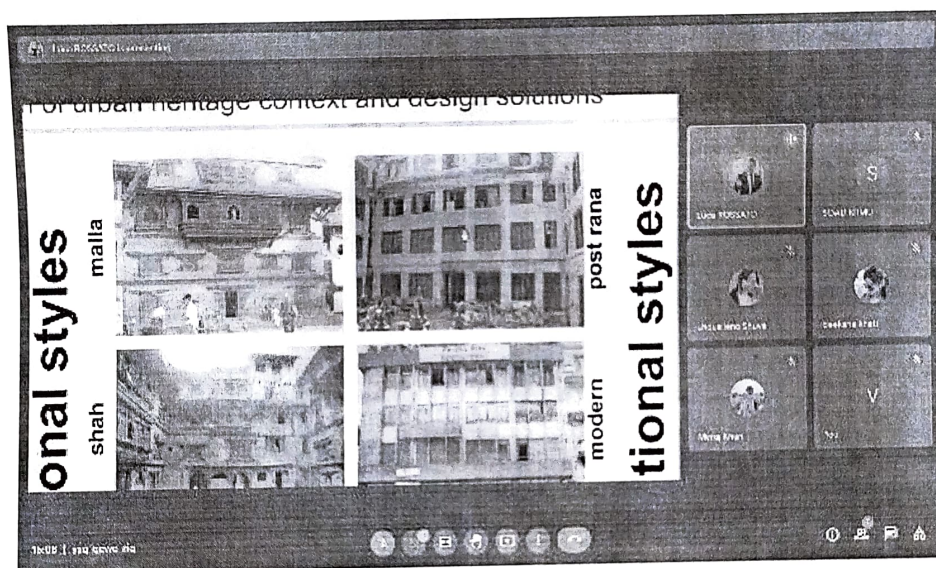


Fig 4 : Photographic Survey
