

The event was an overall success. Students that took part had an overall positive experience with the event. The contest renewed a competitive spirit among students whilst maintaining a healthy environment for learning.



Introduction

Honey is a sweet, viscous food substance made by honey bees and some other bees. [1][2] Bees produce honey from the sugary secretions of plants (floral nectar) or from secretions of other insects (such as honeydew), by regurgitation, enzymatic activity, and water evaporation. Honey extraction is the central process in beekeeping of removing honey from honeycomb so that it is isolated in a pure liquid form. After extraction of honey, its filtration and bottling must be done for its preservation and further marketing.

Objectives

- To train students with the procedure of honey extraction.
- To train students with the procedure of filtration and bottling of honey.

Content

Students of SOAS participated in the honey extraction, filtration and bottling activity held at KRMU campus. The wild honey bee combs were picked up from the high level buildings of KRMU by the professional pickers. The comb with honey were taken to the lab. The students extracted honey from the combs in the big containers (Photo 1). Thus, the raw honey so obtained was filtered twice through the muslin cloth by the students (Photo 2, 3 and 4). The bottles were washed, dried and sterilized in autoclave for filling the honey. The students filled the honey in the clean bottles and sealed with the waterproof lid (Photo 5). Thus, this honey was ready for marketing.




Figure 1. Students Carming groups and received the strong fee their roles for point.






Figure 3: Mr. Govind Kumar Das teaching students about the basics of Madhubani Art




Photo 1: Mr. Amit Tyagi interacting with the participants of the workshop




Photo 3: The Team of Eviz InfoSystems providing hands-on training to the student-teachers on different subject-related applications.

Event Name: Workshop on Essentials of Mooting Target Group: Students of School of Legal Studies

Date: May 20, 2022

Venue: Room 213, A Block

Introduction:

To enhance the knowledge of mooting as a skill among students, School of Legal Studies of K.R. Mangalam University organised an offline workshop on "Essentials of Mooting" on Friday, 20 May, 2022. The aim of the event was to encourage students to get to know about the basics of mooting, and its essential in a law student's life.

Objectives:

The main aim for conducting this workshop was to introduce students with the essentials of mooting. The workshop also aimed at solving many queries of students that are getting started with moot court competitions. Students that seldom take part in activities were motivated to try participating in mooting and develop their oral and speaking skills. Mooting is a form of an oral proceeding similar to that of a court proceeding practiced mainly in institutions and universities where law as a subject is taught to see how efficient a student is in fighting an argument based on law.

About the Guest Speaker:

For the workshop, we had among us Mr. Akash Gupta, an Assistant Professor in Jindal Global Law School where he teaches Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) courses. Also, he serves as the Assistant Editor for Indian Review of International Arbitration, Peer Review Board Member for Indian Arbitration Law Review and Faculty Advisor for Mapping ADR. In addition to academia, Akash has been appointed as an Arbitrator and a Conciliator in several commercial disputes. He completed LL.M. in International Commercial Arbitration Law from Stockholm University. During the LL.M. programme, he participated in the Vis Moot and emerged as the Top 16 out of 372 teams from all over the world and received Honourable Mention for the Best Memorandum for Claimant. Out of approximately 1000 students, he was awarded the 1st Ram Jethmalani Academic Excellence Awards 2018 for Students in the Moot Category.

Content of the Event:

The session was divided into 5 heads, those were: Pre-Memo, Post Memo, Pre-Orals, During Orals and Post Orals. Akash Sir elaborately discussed the meaning, role and importance of participating in Moot Court Competitions. He elaborated upon the manner in which a Memorial is to be drafted and also articulated the importance of research while drafting the memorial. Sir discussed the how basic steps such as Team Formation, Team Building Activities are important for every student,

initially. Sir also explained the importance of a mentor, that every team should have, for good feedback, guidance and even constructive criticism. Significance of an organized time schedule, practice rounds and getting famaliarise with the mooting style, weekly meetings, identifying individuals as well as team's goal was discussed in length. After having discussed the initial steps, sir then explained the structure of the moot memorial, and what steps should be taken by the students to write more effectively.

Topics such as CREAC (Conclusion, Rule, Explanation of Rule, Analysis, Conclusion): is a common approach to organizing analysis of a specific legal issue. CREAC begins with the conclusion and IRAC is an acronym that generally stands for: Issue, Rule, Application, and Conclusion. It functions as a methodology for legal analysis. The IRAC format is mostly used in hypothetical questions in law school and bar exams.

Akash sir, then, started by emphasizing on Speech part of the Moot. One has to regulate speed modulation so as to ensure that the other party and the adjudicator understand one's contentions, it shouldn't be monotonous and mundane. Important aspects of the speech part includes: Time Management, Body Language, Eye Contact, the way in which mooters are dressed. It was suggested that instead of speaking in a monotonous tone, try moderating the speech so that every word of an individual is conveyed with proper emotions and emphasis can be drawn on important facts.

Further, it was explained how to cogently answer the questions and rebuttals raised by the bench, how to deal with exigencies such as hypothetical questions raised by the bench, how to start answering the questions by giving real-time examples through case laws in a way that the situation relates to the preposition and arguments one has made in one's moot proposition.

After the detailed session of covering each and every aspect of the moot competition and its essentials, Sit concluded the session by having everyone engage in an interactive gaming session of MCQs. The application which was used was called as "Kuhoot!". Kahoot! is a game-based learning platform, used as educational technology in schools and other educational institutions. Its learning games, "kahoots", are user-generated multiple-choice quizzes that can be accessed with a web browser or the Kahoot! app.

Outcome of the Lecture:

This workshop was also conducted for all the talented upcoming mooters and to impart great knowledge about mooting. The workshop served to develop good knowledge among the students about the Essentials of Mooting, which included both drafting as well as the speech part. The students had plethora of questions for the guest speaker, which were answered by them to the student's satisfaction.

Conclusion:

The workshop was successfully conducted by fulfilling its aim of imparting knowledge in an interesting way to the students. Students were encouraged and motivated towards engaging in further experiences of Moot court, and through that, developing their speaking as well as drafting skills.



Introduction: The term UI/UX stands for user interface/user experience design and refers to the practice of designing digital products with a user-first approach. UX designers are responsible for making sure that the user's interaction with a digital product is as fast, easy and efficient as possible. They are not concerned with visuals; they map out the user journey and strategise to solve users' pain points and meet their needs. The outcome of that is a wireframe – a blueprint of the product.

UI designers pick up where UX designers leave off. Their role is to bring the digital product to life based on the wireframe provided. Like in the furnishing example – you already have all the functionalities mapped out, and now it is time to decorate.

Objectives: The aim of the UI/UX workshop is to provide students with the knowledge of user-centered design, user -centered methods in design, graphic design on screens, simulation and prototyping techniques, usability testing methods, interface technologies and user centered design in corporate perspective.




Fig. 1: Showing implementation of UX/UI










Figure 1: Speaker explaining steps before moving to hands on learning




Figure 4: Work done by student - Tanya during the workshop
