


Fig : Demonstration of Political Reporting by the Speaker along with involving student participation




Photo-1: The importance of language, timeliness and background knowledge was emphasised.




Photo-2: SJMC student performing the task given in the workshop




Fig: Students' participation in the session and session briefing




Photo-3: Mr Vineet Kumar Singh explaining to the students




Photo-1: The importance of language, timeliness and background knowledge was emphasised.




Photo-2: This event was very enriching for the students, in which they learned a lot about the subject




Photo-3: The student performing the task given in the workshop






Fig: Briefing of the session




Fig: Interactive session by the faculty during the workshop






Fig 1: Skit performance by the students




Fig 2: Briefing of the discussion


Fig 4: Group photograph during the event conclusion

This kind of Live TV session will motivate the students towards choosing right career goals in TV/Broadcasting/Digital Media industries and train them to be job ready in the professional world.





On 29th September 2022, School of Basic and Applied Sciences organized a workshop on "Artificial Intelligence Applied to Materials Discovery and Design" in collaboration with Gargi College, University of Delhi, Delhi under MOU. The main objective to organize the workshop was to explore about the use of machine learning tools for identification of features of any materials and their design with more efficacy. The workshop was started by Dr Neeraj Kumari, Faculty Coordinator by warm welcoming the participants. Dr Neeraj initiated the program after giving a brief introduction about the artificial intelligence and machine learning.

Dr Vandna started her talk from basics of artificial intelligence and machine learning. She told that Artificial Intelligence (AI) has grown into a major tool in scientific and technological era. The main application of AI is to optimize design, production and application of materials due to which materials scientists are attracting more and more towards this area. The developments and advancements in machine learning have opened the door for various new

methods to study phase transitions due to their ability to extremely efficiently identify complex patterns in systems of many particles. The application of machine learning techniques vary from the use of developing new ML-based order parameters for complex crystal structures, to locating phase transitions, to speeding up simulations. She emphasized on importance of AI which is well fitted to manufacturing as it can perform manufacturing, quality control, shorten design time, and reduce materials waste, improve production reuse, perform predictive maintenance, and more.

She highlighted about several categories of Machine Learning according to the target values type and the nature of the issue that has to be solved. These algorithms may be generally characterized as Regression algorithms, Clustering algorithms, and Classification algorithms. Clustering is an example of an unsupervised learning algorithm, in contrast to regression and classification, which are both examples of supervised learning algorithms. Machine learning play an important role in the field of machine intelligence concerned with the design and development of algorithms and models that allow computers to learn without being explicitly programmed.

In the last, she gave an assignment to the students to identify the characteristics of flower using AI/ ML. The students participated very enthusiastically and gave the answer very well. The whole session was very good and interesting for the students and faculty members. The session was ended by Dr Neeraj Kumari with vote of thanks to the guest speaker as well as participants.




Photo 1: A slide showing the importanc of artificial intelligence




Photo 2: A slide showing importanc eof machine learning





School of Agricultural Sciences, K.R. Mangalam University, Gurugram organized seminar on soilless/ hydroponic cultivation and vertical farming of high value horticultural crops on 17th March, 2023. The session started with the welcome note by Dr. S.S. Sharma, Dean SOAS, and he explained status of present agriculture and its importance in Indian GDP. The event was coordinated by Dr. Vikas Kumar Sharma (Assistant Professor - SOAS) and gave a informative lecture on production technology of high value horticulture crops under vertical hydroponic system. He said that high value fruits and vegetable crops are very sensitive and generally grown in soil worldwide and a number of organisms affect almost all parts including roots, stem, crown, leaves and fruits. He further said that the pesticides used in agriculture can contaminate soil, water, turf, and other vegetation. In addition to killing insects or weeds, pesticides can be toxic to a host of other organisms including birds, fish, beneficial insects, and non-target plants.

Thus there is increased demand for a suitable technology adapted to soilless culture by growing crops in different artificial media like perlite, cocopeat, vermiculite, moss, coir, saw dust and vermicompost. To eliminate the soil borne diseases and pest the use of artificial media is gaining popularity and number of soilless substrate/ media can be used to substitute the soil for plant growth and production. He also enlighten the effect of urbanization on agriculture and said urbanization leads to a continuous loss of agricultural land, both directly under the form of land take, and indirectly through the use of agricultural land for nonproductive activities. The land is also very expensive so to cultivate the crops, so the vertical space needs to be utilized by modifying the plant geometry to obtain higher productivity and quality produce. Because in some crops (leafy vegetables) the yield is mainly related to the number of plants rather than the area.












Photo 6: Explaining Hardware concepts




Fig 1: Students attending the online workshop session




Fig 2: Students having an interactive discussion with the speaker




Fig 4: Facilitation of the speaker



Revit Architecture is a powerful Building Information Modeling (BIM) program that works the way Architects think. From Preliminary Design through Design Development, and into Construction Documents, the program streamlines the design process with a central 3D model. Changes made in one view update across all views and on the printable sheets.

School of Architecture and Design organized Workshop on Revit at K. R. Mangalam University, Sohna Road campus on 14th October 2022. The objective of the workshop was to enable students to create full 3D architectural project models and set them up in working drawings. Total 38 Students attended the workshop from Bachelor of Architecture and Bachelor of Interior Design. The Workshop was organized to bridge the gap between the market needs and the students, ensuring a smooth workflow between the two. Workshop was started by external expert Kumar Utkarsh with the introduction and concept of Revit in the field of Architecture. Workshop was designed in a manner that students will learn basic commands and be able to produce or design drawings on that. 



Gurushala is an initiative of Indus Towers Ltd. and Vodafone Idea Foundation and is implemented by Pratham Education Foundation. The idea driving Gurushala dates back to 2012 when a digital education programme was piloted in 151 under-resourced and low-cost schools across India. The programme aimed to positively impact the learning levels of students by equipping schools with digital technology and training upper-primary math and science teachers to integrate technology and innovative group learning pedagogies inside the classroom.

Over the years, the programme worked with schools across diverse geographies, cultures, languages and other socio-economic characteristics. In this process, it generated a rich pool of knowledge and insights about the problems that Indian teachers face inside their classrooms and innovative and scalable solutions to solve those problems. Digital skills and e-content tools would have help students to understand the content in more informative way and engage them in class room situation which eventually make teaching-learning process more interactive. E- content is the expression broadly used to describe —instructional content or learning experience delivered. The broader definition can include the use of the Internet, intranets/extranets, audio-and videotape, satellite broadcast, interactive TV, and CDROM, not only for content delivery, but also for interaction among participants. Since the demands and conditions of today's youth are different from those of 10 years ago . Today, new generations are expected to have a high level of digital competence because they are constantly evolving. To do this, an educator must have up-to-date training and a high level of digital competence. Using digital skills in classroom have many advantages that help the teacher to teach and evaluate students in an agile and effective way .



RATIONALE

21st century students learn in a global classroom and not necessarily within four wall . The rapid advance of digital technologies has significantly impacted education in recent years. Digital skills are a step towards learning lots of other new things . Educators must understand that the use of e-content will improve teaching and learning and thus enhance educational opportunities and benefit the Millennial . The advancement of digital technologies has been impacting the education system, especially during and after the COVID times. To keep up pace with the changing times, the teaching and learning processes in a classroom also need to be changed. Thus, to develop digital competencies for an effective teaching and learning process by making the teachers understand the trends in technology, the School of Education, K.R. Mangalam University, organized an online Technology Enhancement Workshop on Digital Skills for

Educators & E-Content Development in Collaboration with Gurushala at Pratham Education Foundation. Ms. Neetu Bartwal and Ms. Aakriti Adya from Gurushala were the invited speakers for the workshop.

Ms. Manju Kundu, Assistant Professor, School of Education welcomed the participants and guest speakers of the day and introduced the speakers to the participants. The session was conducted on the digital platform of Gurushala. Prof. Tania Gupta, Dean, School of Education gave a brief introduction about the essence of scheduling this workshop and the Gurushala. There were more than 125 participants who attended the workshop. The participants who joined this session were the student-teachers from various colleges, research scholars, school teachers, assistant and associate professors, and principals of different colleges. Various Deans and Directors from not only the Education department but from other departments also participated. The participants who joined the session belonged to different states like Delhi, Tamil Nadu, Haryana, Maharashtra, Uttar Pradesh, Maharashtra, Jammu & Kshmir, Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Rajasthan, Gujarat, Himachal Pradesh, Assam, Madhya Pradesh, Kerala, Chattisgarh etc. The session began with an activity for the participants; 'Solve the Riddle' by both the speakers wherein they asked some riddles from the participants. They then continued and focused on the changes which COVID has brought in the classrooms and what skills a teacher must possess to deal with the changing demands of the students in a classroom. With the shift from physical classrooms to digital classrooms, the education system has been demanding digital expertise on the behalf of teachers and students. They, thus, discussed the importance of technical skills, teamwork and leadership, communication skills and enhanced pedagogical skills, critical thinking and creativity for present-day teachers. They conducted an activity where the speakers asked the participants, how they actually go about collecting the reading material for their students (Picture 1). Elaborating upon the answers given by the participants, they said that there are five pillars which may bring digital competencies in teaching. These are computerization and information literacy, communication and elaboration, creation of digital content, security and problem-solving.

In order to familiarize the participants with the various digital tools available (Picture 2) and how they can develop the content by integrating technology and pedagogy, they discussed the formula DC^2 where depending upon the situation, the teachers can go with



high-tech methods or low-tech methods. By using this rule, they can integrate technology with pedagogy depending upon the technological support available to the students. They also demonstrated the various modalities to use the Gurushala website and how any participant can create their own modules or may use the already existing ones (Picture 3). Towards the end of the session, the participants were made aware that a separate community by the name 'teachers of K. R. Mangalam Community' has been created on the Gurushala website (Picture 4) and how the teachers and student-teachers of K. R. Mangalam university can contribute in it by putting up the digital content created by them. The session was concluded by presenting a summary of what has been covered by the speakers in the session and a formal vote of thanks was given by Dr. Anshul Saluja, Assistant Professor, School of Education, K. R. Mangalam University (Picture 5). The participants learnt how they can develop e-content for their students by keeping the needs and demands of children in consideration. A majority of participants said that they wish to attend such workshops in the near future. They suggested that sessions may be conducted on developing health and hygines, how to use various google softwares, developing critical thinking and creativity etc. which may be helpful for the teachers in their teaching-learning process.




Picture 1 Activity being conducted by the speakers




Picture 4 Speakers demonstrating the Teachers of K.R. Mangalam University community on Gurushala portal
