


Figure 1: Group Photo of the Pharmacy & Physiotherapy Students



The students participated in the competition with great zeal and zest. They also learnt the nuances of shooting PTC's and newswriting during this process.





Organizing such type of workshop increases the gathering, filtering and visualizing abilities of the students.






Photo-1: Mr Ashar Khan emphasising on the importance of body language, verbal communication, presentation skills and background knowledge of subject


