

**Introduction:** According to the World Health Organisation (2021), One in six people are aged 10-19 years. Adolescence is a unique and formative time. Physical, emotional and social changes, including exposure to poverty, abuse, or violence, can make adolescents vulnerable to mental health problems. Protecting adolescents from adversity, promoting socio-emotional learning and psychological well-being, and ensuring access to mental health care are critical for their health and well-being during adolescence and adulthood.

When the youth learn to cope with immense emotions or calm themselves down in difficult or emotional situations, they are likely to feel good about themselves. By talking about

#### Objectives:

- 1. Comprehend the emotions and management of emotion among youth in daily life.
- 2. Appreciate the role of educational institutions in fostering mental health and well-being among the youth.
- 3. Create sensitization on mental health issues among adolescents and the youth.

#### Methodology: Panel discussion

Content: Dr. Pratibha Singh, Consultant Clinical Psychologist & Director, KIBPM, during the panel discussion deliberated upon the concept of mental health and well-being among the youth. She focused on the mental health concerns frequently seen among youth. She emphasized that the use of tobacco, alcohol and substance abuse by youth is highly common and becoming a great concern these days. She asserted that the role of parents and parenting style is extremely vital in ensuring the Mental health and well-being of youth. She also focused on preventive ways or self-curative strategies that one can practice as a youngster to ensure good mental health for self.

Dr. Anita Sharma, Psychiatrist, KIPBM reflected on the red flags that need to be noticed among the youth regarding their mental health for consulting a Psychiatrist. She focused on psychiatric drugs and the mindset of people that one gets addicted to these so these should be avoided. She explained the role of a Psychiatrist in dealing with alcohol and drug de-addiction.

Prof. Tania Gupta, Dean, School of Humanities focused her deliberations on common mental health concerns often seen or encountered among young students today in the University system and stressed on strategies that can be adopted to address these in an educational setting.








Photo 1: Mr. Manas Ranjan discussed about Entrepreneurship & How to start new business








Photo 1: Dr. Ruchika Yadav connecting students with meditation.




Photo 2: Students and Faculties taking session on Yoga and Mediatation.





Dr. Nisha Yadav interacted with students and shared her knowledge on the topic of the seminar. During her talk she shared that the water is one of the most essential resources on Earth and necessary for the survival of all living species. Water plays a significant role in human life. Only 1% of the freshwater is available for drinking. Water pollution occurs when a body of water becomes contaminated, usually by chemicals or microorganisms. Water pollution can cause water to become toxic for humans and the environment. Water is referred to as the universal solvent, as it dissolves most of the substances than any other liquid. However, this ability means that water is easily prone to pollution.

She also shared that since the 1990s, water pollution has worsened in almost all river in Asia, Latin America, and Africa. Around 785 million people do not have basic drinking-water services. Over half the global populations do not have safely managed sanitation services. Experts estimate that by 2025, half the world's population will live in a water-stressed environment. Around 2 billion people live in countries with high levels of water stress, meaning the amount of water available is less than the amount required.

Dr. Nisha Yadav discussed with students about sanitation which is the process of keeping

places free from dirt, infection, disease, etc. by removing waste, trash and garbage, by cleaning streets washing hands and drinking safe water. Sanitation and hygiene are crucial for everyone since they aid in the maintenance of health and the extension of life spans. Sanitation is another very important aspect. Many of the common diseases such as roundworms spread through the faces of infected people. By ensuring that people do not defecate in the open, we can completely eliminate such diseases and even more severe ones such as the one caused by E. Coli. Worldwide, one in three people do not have access to safe drinking water, two out of five people do not have a basic hand-washing facility with soap and water, and more than 673 million people still practice open defectation.

Then Dr. Nisha Yadav recommended that the sensitizing people about the ill effect of sanitation in their surroundings and the need to draw attention to the water-related threats to nutrition that are intensified by climate change, especially in regions already facing a high purden of child stunting. Finally, she concluded that there is a need for more experience and guidance to support equitable and nutrition-sensitive use of water resources both within and across countries. With the right policies in place, countries will be better positioned to harness the power of water for improving nutrition and strengthening human capital. Interventions that encourage a healthy lifestyle or provide education about nutrients and supplements may help decrease the prevalence of malnutrition. Treatment usually involves assessment by a doctor and recommendations from a dictitian. The seminar left an impactful impression on students' mind; they got many useful information about unsafe water, sanitation and hygiene and steps that can be taken up to improve quality of water and human health.







Taping is commonly used as an adjunct or temporary technique. Athletes often make use of taping as a protective mechanism in the presence of an existing injury. Some of the goals with taping are to restrict the movement of injured joints, soft tissue compression to reduce swelling. support anatomical structures, and as protection from re-injury. Taping is used as one of the means of rehabilitation or prophylaxis in instances where support and stability are needed, as a first-aid tool, for the prevention of injury and protection of an injured anatomical structure while healing is taking place.

The objective of the workshop was to familiarize the students of BPT 5<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> Semester with the various kinds of Taping Techniques used in the field of Physiotherapy and give a Hands – on training for use of Rigid taping Technique for management of various conditions in lower limb. After giving the overview about the tapes and various methods of application, demonstration for taping for various conditions affecting lower limb was done to make students understand how to perform the procedure. Post demonstration, students were given tapes to practice on the model for hands – on experience and better learning. Resource person was available to sort any kind of doubts that came during the practice.

- mechanical effects
- neuromuscular effects
- psychological effects

Also, they were briefed about different kinds of tape that can be employed:

- Rigid strapping tape commonly used in taping or strapping is often referred to as "sports tape" or "athletic tape" and is most often a rigid style of strapping tape.
- Elastic strapping tape can also be used when less rigidity or support is required.
- Kinesiology tape is an improved version of elastic sports tape that acts to dynamically assist your muscle function.

Students were given chance to practically apply the technique on the model and experience the effect it had on person in real time.

Students liked and enjoyed the hands – on experience of the workshop and said it will help the in their professional development as well.

Further training with other tapes can be conducted for overall development of students.



# **Activity Outcome**






