


Outcome

Conclusion



Introduction: The Science Club was started by School of Basic and Applied Sciences with an aim intended to invite many eminent scientists/ academicians who would share their experience with the students and motivate them to get scientific knowledge. Science Club is one of the better platforms for the students across different discipline to realize their scientific skills, knowledge and fulfill their quest in doing science activities for which they do not get opportunities within the curriculum framework. Activities are designed primarily to introduce students to undertake interesting/exciting science and technology projects.

In the academic session of 2021-22, Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam Science Club has organized various events under different themes. As a part of science society events, "Sudoku competition" was organized on 23rd February 2022 to enhance the concentration, develop problem solving skills and promote a healthy mindset in students.

The Sudoku is a puzzle game for students where students need to fill in a 9×9 grid with digits so that each column, row, and 3×3 section contain the numbers between 1 to 9 but any row, column or 3×3 grid should not have more than one of the same number. It doesn't require any calculation or special math skills. The game was first invented by Howard Garns, a puzzle inventor from Indiana in 1979 and called in number place. In 2004, Sudoku made its first appearance in U. S. and London newspaper.
