IQAC Director welcomed everyone in the 12th meeting of IQAC and asked permission from chairman to conduct the meeting. Following agenda were placed before the members:

Agenda 12.01: To confirm the 11th Meeting of IQAC held on April 20, 2022

The minutes of 11th Meeting of IQAC held on April 20, 2022, were circulated. No comments were received, and minutes were confirmed (Annexure I).



Agenda 12.02: To report action taken on minutes of 11th meeting held on April 20, 2022

Action taken report as per annexure II was considered and approved.

Agenda 12.03: To report the IQAC initiatives for the academic session 2021-22 and future qualitative initiatives

IQAC Director put up the summary report of initiatives and work done (Annexure III) before the members and following suggestions were received:

- To develop an effective teaching-learning process, faculty may be requested to prepare 15-20 MCQs, 4 short answer and 2 long answer questions per unit per course. Out of 20 MCQs, 5 questions will be of competitive level. Prof. Tania Gupta and Dr. Diwakar will monitor this for the entire university. The Answer key for MCQs, Bullet answer key indicators, and the step wise marking scheme for short and long answers need to be provided by the faculty. This will enable university to create database for digital library.
- List of Value-added courses and Open elective courses is to be shared by Academic Office with Schools.
- Faculty may be requested to prepare Course Timetable and evaluate students through Group discussion/ presentation/Quiz/ Project work etc. after every three lectures (12-15 evaluation in each semester). This will enable faculty for early recognition of slow learner and prepare strategy for them.
- In the timetable, Library, Sports, Music, and Yoga sessions may be assigned to cater to students' academic development, physical and mental well-being, and hobbies. This will also enable students to prepare for inter-university festivals.
- IQAC is requested to identify the NAAC matrices where one year report is required, or 5year record is required.
- Faculty may be requested to identify problems facing India through the PM website and UGC dashboard and, after approval, provide them to students for research projects and internships.
- Each faculty may be requested to identify and download a minimum of 5 books from OPEN Educational Resources and five URLs of research papers and study materials useful for students and forward them to a librarian for the creation of the digital library.
- As per guidelines faculty may be requested to prepare E-SLM content.
- The record of environmental practices adopted in the university such as solar, rainwater harvesting, sewage treatment etc. needs to be maintained regularly.

It was also apprised that IQAC Coordinator Prof. Neeraj Gupta has already shared formats of reports (Field Projects, Internships, Research Projects, Conference FDPs, Events) with faculty for documentation purposes.



Agenda 12.04: To report the Stakeholders' Feedback Analysis for Academic Session 2021-22.

Agenda 12.05: To report summary of events (workshops, conferences, extension activities, expert talks etc.) organized by Schools for even semester 2021-22

Director IQAC placed the summary sheet of events organized by each school before the committee (Annexure V). Members took note of it. Members were also apprised that the event calendar for the forthcoming semester (odd semester 2022-23) has also been finalised. The Vice Chancellor emphasized that schools must plan their events, including feedback forms, survey forms, etc., as per the event calendar one week before and get it approved by VC and PVC on the Note sheet.
