Director IQAC welcomed the members of IQAC to the meeting. With the permission of the Chair, she presented the agenda before the committee. IQAC Chairman acknowledged the efforts of faculty to collect the necessary documents for submission to NAAC. Director IQAC presented the agenda of the meeting before the members.

Agenda 6.01 To confirm the minutes and action taken of 5th IQAC Meeting

Minutes of 5th meeting of IQAC were circulated and as no objections were obtained, minutes were confirmed (Annexure I).

Agenda 6.02 To ratify E-Governance Report of KRMU

Dr Kiran Bala presented the e-governance report for AY 2018-2019. The members suggested improvements in the ERP system and increased Internet Speed for students and faculty members (Annexure II).



Agenda 6.03 To report the curriculum reforms adopted for academic year 2019-20

It was reported in the meeting that the University has adopted the Choice-Based Credit System (CBCS), having a pool of open electives and value-added courses from the academic session 2019-20. This would enable students to choose electives as per their interests and enable them to be more competitive. It was also reported that the University has adopted a project-based learning approach for effective teaching-learning.

Chairman IQAC emphasized that sessions to raise awareness about environmental sustainability, gender sensitization, ethics, etc., need to be conducted by various clubs and societies of the University.

Agenda 6.04: To report action taken on the feedback received from stakeholders for Academic year 2018-2019

The feedback for the curriculum was received from various stakeholders for the academic session 2018-19, and the action taken report was presented before the committee. Members noted the same (Annexure III).

Agenda 6.05: To report the organization of Alumni Meet

The meeting reported that the Alumni Meet was held on October 12, 2019, at K.R. Mangalam University Campus. The event provided an opportunity for the KRMU Alumni to connect with their alma mater and with the industry experts who were invited as chief guests (Annexure-IV). It was also suggested that Alumni Association Registration is important for getting support and contribution from alumni.

Agenda 6.06: To report organisation of Summer School at University of the West of England, Bristol, United Kingdom

Fifteen students of 2018 MBA batch attended a two-week Business Summer School at the University of West of England, Bristol's Frenchay campus from July 15-26, 2019. Apart from attending lecture, the programme also included UK Culture classes and cultural visits in the South of England including Bristol, Bath, Gloucester, Oxford and London (Annexure V). Members appreciated the efforts of the university to promote international exposure to the students.



Agenda 6.07: To report IQAC initiatives.

i. Organization of Legal and Management Summit on Oct 10, 2019

School of Legal Studies (SOLS) & School of Management and commerce (SOMC) at K.R. Mangalam university jointly organized Legal and Management Summit on 10th October 2019 which focused on the “**Emerging trends in Human Resource: Managerial and Legal Perspective**”. It was reported in the meeting that K.R.
