The State Govt. hereby authorizes you to start following programs/schools:-

1. School of Law

- (i) B.A. LL.B. (Hons.)-5 years
- (ii) LLB Hons.-3 years

2. School of Journalism & Mass Communication

- (i) Bachelor of Journalism & Mass Communication-3 years
- (ii) Master of Journalism & Mass Communication-2 years
- (iii) Bachelor of Mass Media-3 years

3. School of Education

- (i) Bachelor of Education-1 year
- (ii) Bachelor of Elementary Education-4 years

4. School of Hotel Management & Catering Technology

- (i) Bachelor of Hotel Management & Catering Technology-4 years

5. School of Nursing

- (i) B.Sc. Nursing-4 years

6. School of Fashion

- (i) B.A. (Fashion Design)-3 years

7. School of Humanities

- (i) B.A. (Hons.) English-3 years
- (ii) B.A. (Hons.) Economics-3 years

8. Ph.D. in existing and new proposed Schools

Permission to start these courses is allowed on the following conditions:

- 1. Adequate emphasis must be laid on the communication skills. Communicative English should be made an integral part of the curriculum across disciplines.

2. Ph.D. may only be offered in those disciplines/ courses where faculty with qualifications (Ph.D. or higher) as prescribed by the Universities Grants Commission exists.
3. UGC Regulations, 2009 regarding Ph.D. shall be followed in letter and spirit while introducing Ph.D. programmes.
4. The faculty to be engaged should be well qualified and competent as prescribed by the UGC.
5. Requisite approvals of concerned regulatory bodies namely UGC, AICTE, BCI, NCTE and Nursing Council must be obtained for starting the proposed courses.
