Systematic collection and evaluation of stakeholder feedback therefore serve as an essential mechanism for maintaining academic relevance and ensuring alignment with emerging educational and industry trends.

For the academic session 2024–25, the Feedback Committee under the aegis of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) at K.R. Mangalam University carried out an extensive feedback exercise involving multiple stakeholders. - Enhance teaching approaches to address varying student abilities and real-life applications.


Consolidated Action Taken
