Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)

This MOU is arrived at this 17th Day of April 2023.

Between

K.R. Mangalam University, Sohna, Haryana through its Authorized Signatory Registrar, presently Gp. Capt. P. Mahajan. KR Mangalam University, Sohna, Haryana. The University has been established under the Haryana Private Universities Act 2006 (Amended 08 of 2013) and under section 2(f) of UGC Act, 1956 wherein it is empowered to award degrees, as specified under section 22 of the UGC Act, 1956 hereinafter referred to as **"The University"**, or the **"First Party"** (which expression shall, unless it be repugnant to the context or meaning thereof be deemed to mean and include its successors and permitted assigns) of the One Part.

And

The Climate Project Foundation, through its Authorized Signatory Mr. Aditya Pundir, Director, the Climate Project Foundation, a not-for-profit organization working in the field of climate change education and advocacy and having its Registered Office address as- The Climate Project Foundation, 513, 5th Floor, Narain Manzil, Barakhamba Road, New Delhi -110001, India, hereinafter referred to as **'The TCPF'**, or the **'Second Party'** (which expression shall, unless it be repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to mean and include its successors and permitted assigns) of the Other Part.

And

Environmental and Consumer Protection Foundation hereinafter referred to as **'ECPFO'**, or the **'Third Party'** (which expression shall, unless it be repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to mean and include its successors and permitted assigns) of the Other Part.

'The University', **'The TCPF'** and **'The ECPFO'** are hereinafter, collectively referred to as the **'Parties'** and individually as the **'Party'**.

Whereas

- KR Mangalam University, Sohna (the University) is constituted by an Act of the State Legislature of Haryana and recognized by the UGC with the right to confer degrees as per Section 22 (1) of the UGC Act, 1956 and the University is also one of the members of the esteemed Association of Indian Universities and
- The University has become one of the leading Universities of North India in a very short span of time due to its commitment to provide quality education in different fields of knowledge such as Engineering, Education, Management, Pharmacy, Health Sciences, Law,

- Architecture, Mass Communication and such other disciplines and the other Party, i.e.
- The Climate Project Foundation (TCPF) is working with partners for creating awareness on Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) of the United Nations continues to expand its work in the field of , climate change, clean energy, e-mobility with a special focus on working together with schools, colleges and Universities to implement and take climate change and environmental sustainability message to teachers, students and parents through its 'Teachers Training on Climate Change Program'
 - TCPF also inspires conventional campuses to turn into green campuses under its Green Campus Program and is already conducting these programs in many schools & colleges all over the country and
 - TCPF has also approached the University for implementing these two Programs on the University campus and both the Parties are interested in collaborating to implement these two programs on the University Campus.
 - The Environmental & Consumer Protection Foundation (ECPFO) was founded & Registered in May 1993 with a Mission to give Environmental solutions. They have been planting Trees in Delhi NCR and have so far planted over 1 million Trees.
 - ECPFO has been presently functioning based on 17 SDG's set by the United Nations in 2015 for Global sustainability achievements. They work on waste segregation, water conservation, restoration of lakes, conducting workshops in colleges, universities & among NCC Cadets to create awareness about Environmental issues & techniques. ECPFO also provides Clean Air Solutions. The system handles and eliminates air pollution and provides sterilized safe Air Zones by treating Ambient Air Pollution comprising diverse particulate pollutants of Microbial contaminations like Virus & bacteria.

Therefore,

- It is mutually understood and agreed by and between the Parties to collaborate through this MoU, to achieve the objectives and the terms of collaboration mentioned herein below:

Objectives

- To spread awareness in the students, faculty and surrounding community on environmental issues such as climate change, conservation of natural resources, use of renewable energy resources, solid waste management, water conservation and rainwater harvesting, tree plantation, e- mobility and similar other issues.
- To help the University in implementing "Green Campus Program" in the University.
- "Green Campus Program" is a physical campus transformative process to build a sustainable campus, by implementing renewable energy solutions through solar panels, rainwater


- harvesting, waste segregation and composting in campus, development of green spaces, improving air quality and so on, thus creating a healthier campus for the students.
- To implement "Teachers Training on Climate Change Program" in the University so that subsequently, the teachers and educators may spread awareness and create positive change about the issues in other schools, colleges, and community.
 - To develop teaching contents on environmental issues and make it readily available digitally to the University for implementation.
 - To undertake seminars, workshops, conclaves, training, meetings, campaigns and conferences in collaborations and partnerships with government and non-government agencies on climate change and related environmental issues.
 - To undertake any other activities and share programs and resources that will address sustainability education, climate change and other environmental issues for the betterment of the students, University teachers and our country at large.


Resolution

- The University, ECPFO and TCPF resolve to jointly implement the following programs of TCPF in the University campus:
 - Teachers Training on Climate Change Program and
 - Green Campus Program.
 - ECPFO, would like to plant trees, develop medicinal Nursery, conduct workshops to create awareness, waste segregation, provide clean air and recycling of all waste generated in your campus.
- After signing this MoU, a detailed action plan will be prepared by TCPF and ECPFO in coordination with the University SPOC person (please see Clause 6) to implement the above Programs.
- The said Programs will be implemented within a time frame of one year.
- If the programs could not be implemented within the agreed timeframe of one year due to unexpected events like pandemic, natural disaster or any unforeseen events of force majeure nature, the timeline will be extended by one year by mutual agreement.

Nature

- This MoU is non-exclusive in nature. Parties shall be free to enter similar MoUs with any other Party during currency or the extended currency of this MoU.
- This MoU is non-binding, non-enforceable and non-financial in nature.
- The university shall use its own funds and resources for implementing programs under collaboration under this MoU. TCPF will provide consultancy services for which no fee will







be charged by TCPF.

Term and Termination

- The MoU shall come into force immediately upon its signing by the parties. The MoU will be in force for an initial period of one year. The MoU may be extended further for one year on the mutually agreed terms.
- This MoU may be terminated by mutual consent of the parties before the aforesaid term of one (1) year.
- This MoU can be terminated by either of the parties by giving advance notice of one (1) month period without jeopardizing the ongoing collaborative undertakings i.e., to say that the implementation and/or continuance of programmes or project established pursuant to this MoU prior to the effective date of termination shall not be affected by the termination of this MoU.

Force Majeure

- The Parties shall not be liable for any failure to perform, any of its obligations under this MoU if the performance is prevented, hindered, or delayed by a Force Majeure event (defined below) and in such case its obligations shall be suspended for so long as the Force Majeure event continues.
- "Force Majeure Event" means an event which is beyond the reasonable control of the Parties concerned, including, without limitation, unavailability of any communication system, sabotage, fire, flood, explosion, acts of God, civil commotion, strikes or industrial action of any kind, riots, insurrection, war or acts of government etc.
- Each party shall promptly inform the other of the existence of a Force Majeure event and shall consult together to find a mutually acceptable solution.

Single Point of Contact (SPOC) Persons



- The SPOC person will be responsible for information flow and communication between the Parties.


