## **DAY 2: 21<sup>ST</sup> MAY 2024**

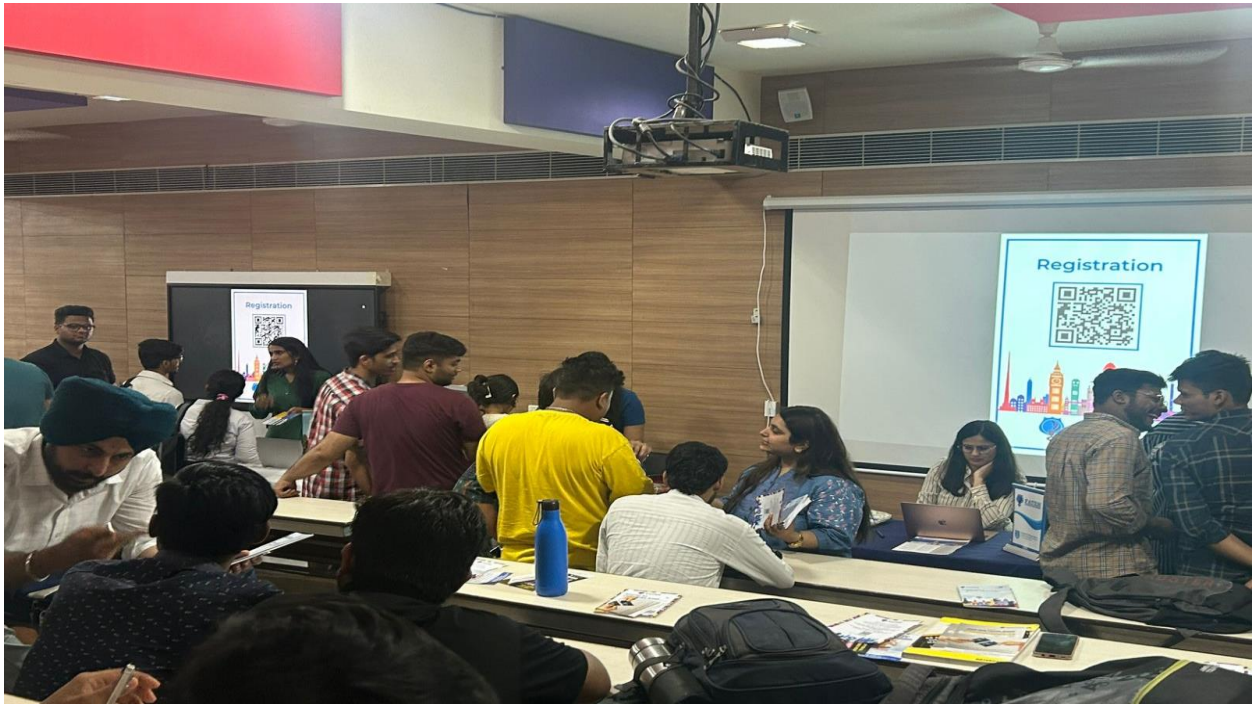
