2. A comprehensive presentation by the resource person Prof. (Dr.) Bob Townley.
3. An interactive Q&A session where students could ask specific questions and receive detailed responses.

Content

Economic Uncertainty

- Impact on Businesses: Discussion on how economic volatility, fluctuating markets, and financial instability affect business operations, planning, and sustainability.

Technological Disruption

- Rapid Advancements: Examination of the pace at which technology is evolving and the risk of existing business models becoming obsolete.

Workforce Diversity and Inclusion

- Diversity Imperatives: Importance of ensuring diversity and inclusion to foster innovation and address social expectations.

Outcome

The session yielded several noteworthy outcomes, including –

1. Enhanced Understanding of Contemporary Challenges

Participants gained a comprehensive understanding of the major challenges currently facing management and organizations.

2. Commitment to Sustainability and Corporate Social Responsibility
