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MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

The Memorandum of Understanding is executed on ____ day of _____ 2023.

BETWEEN

K.R. Mangalam University, Sohna Road, Gurgaon - 122103 (Delhi NCR Region), a University established under the Haryana Private Universities Act 2006 (Amended 08 of 2013) and under section 2(f) of UGC Act, 1956 wherein empowered to award degrees, as specified under section 22 of the UGC Act, 1956. The university is signing MOU through its Registrar, presently Gp. Capt. P. Mahajan is duly authorized to enter into and sign an MOU on behalf of K.R. Mangalam University, **PARTY OF THE FIRST PART.**

AND

Dr. K N Modi Institute of Pharmaceutical Education & Research (DR. KNMIPER), recognized and approved by Pharmacy Council of India (PCI), New Delhi, and All India Council for Technical Education (A.I.C.T.E.), New Delhi, Accredited by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) through its Director/ Authorised Signatory of DR. KNMIPER duly authorized to enter into and sign an MoU on behalf of Dr. K. N Modi Foundation **PARTY OF THE SECOND PART.**

The Expressions "KRMU" and Dr. K N Modi Institute of Pharmaceutical Education & Research (DR. KNMIPER)" shall mean and include their respective successions, legal representations and assignees.

KRMU and DR. KNMIPER are collaborating for Academic Exchange & Cooperation in Education, Research and Training in the areas of, Pharmacy.

Both parties herein agree as follows:

1. Joint sponsored Research, Development and Consulting:

DR. KNMIPER and KRMU agree to investigate ways of identifying and inviting faculty members from the other institutions to participate in ongoing research and development

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programmes of mutual interest. It is anticipated that the terms and conditions for such participation would be worked out mutual agreement between the faculty members and the institution extending such invitation. Further DR. KNMIPER and KRMU agree to jointly identify and pursue opportunities for formulation and submission of new research project proposals for training programmes for possible funding by external agencies if needed. The terms and conditions for such joint research would be worked out between the concerned investigators and the funding agency.

2. Exchange of faculty, Scientist and Staff:

DR. KNMIPER and KRMU agree to explore ways of encouraging collaboration between faculty and scientist from the two institutions. Specifically the two institutions would encourage members of their faculty undertake short visits or take up fixed term assignment as visiting professor. The terms and conditions for each visit or an assignment, including those concerning stipend, travel and housing would be worked out between the partner institutions.

3. Student Exchange:

DR. KNMIPER and KRMU agree to discuss the means for enabling the exchange of student at undergraduate, Graduate and Doctoral level between the two institutions. Each exchange student would be selected by mutual argument and in accordance to the regulations to the regulations of the partner institutions. Further, DR. KNMIPER and KRMU will explore ways to provide for and facilitate joint guidance of thesis under their Ph.D and other post graduate degree programmes.

4. Exchange of Scientific and Technical Material:

DR. KNMIPER and KRMU will examine ways of exchanging information on research and educational programmes and Teaching / Learning material and other literature relevant to their educational and research programmes. Further both agree to explore ways to share teaching / learning material (including electronic / webcast of lecturer etc.) and other relevant literature, subject to each Institutions policy on intellectual property and publications. When a faculty member visits the other institution on invitation or as part of such joint activity, then such a visit would be classified as such, and handled as per rules of individual Institution or as per the terms of this MoU.

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5. Joint conferences, workshop and short- term courses:

DR. KNMIPER and KRMU agree to seek means of identifying and inviting faculty member from the other Institution to participate in conferences, workshop and short courses. The terms and conditions of such participation would be worked out by mutual agreement between the invited faculty member(s) and the Institution extending such invitation. When the faculty member visits the other institution on invitation or as part of such joint activity, then such a visit would be classified as such and handled as per rules of Individual Institution or as per terms of this MoU.

6. Intellectual Property:

DR. KNMIPER and KRMU agree to respect each other's rights to intellectual property. All background IP used in connection with this MoU shall remain the property of the party that introduces it. No license is granted to any party to use another party's background IP unless specifically agreed to in writing. Further the intellectual property rights that arise as a result of any collaborative research of joint activity under this MoU would be subject to separate written agreement/s on the ownership and management of such intellectual property.

And each party agrees to respect the ownership of IP of the other parties in all dealings consistent with officially laid down IRP policies of the partner Institutions.

7. Co-ordination:

The arrangement is suggested for the cooperation of collaboration; each of the Institution (DR. KNMIPER and KRMU) shall appoint one member of its teaching / research faculty to coordinate the programme on its behalf. Programme coordinator from DR. KNMIPER and KRMU will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two Institutions.

8. There will be no financial liability on part of either party.
9. The scope and duration of the collaboration may be amended and/or extended through the joint agreement further with the consent and approval of both parties.
10. This MoU will come into force upon affixing of signatures of the representatives of the partner institutions and will remain in effect for three (3) years.
11. This MoU may be renewed upon its expiry, with the agreement of both the partner institutions. If either partner institution wishes to terminate the MoU at the end of three


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years, it must notify the other institution not less than six months prior to the expiry of the MoU.

12. This MoU or its renewal and the actions taken under it may be reviewed at any time. Modifications may be made by mutual agreement and any amendment or extension to the agreement may be formalized by the exchange of letters between the two parties.






