



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This MoU made and entered into on this 11th day of August, 2023.

Between

K.R. Mangalam University, Sohna Road, Gurgaon - 122103 (Delhi NCR Region), a University established under the Haryana Private Universities Act 2006 (Amended 08 of 2013) and under section 2(f) of UGC Act, 1956 wherein empowered to award degrees, as specified under section 22 of the UGC Act, 1956, hereinafter referred to as the "**KRMU**". The university is signing MOU through its **Registrar**, presently **Gp. Capt. P. Mahajan** is duly authorized to enter into and sign an MOU on behalf of K.R. Mangalam University,

PARTY OF THE FIRST PART.

And

Al-Ameen College of Pharmacy, Bangalore, Karnataka hereinafter called **AACP** the oldest pioneer Institution established in the year 1983 under the aegis of Al-Ameen Educational Society, Bangalore-560027, INDIA, hereinafter referred to as the "**AACP**". The AACP is signing MOU through its Principal, presently **Dr. Md Salahuddin** is duly authorized to enter into and sign an MOU on behalf of **Al-Ameen College of Pharmacy**, **PARTY OF THE SECOND PART.**


WHEREAS the two parties recognize human resource development and institutional capacity building as the basis for a mutually beneficial cooperation program, hereinafter referred to as the Program.

ARTICLE I: OBJECTIVES OF THE PROGRAM

The objectives of the Program are to provide higher education opportunities for faculty, support staff and students of KRMU and AACP promote institutional linkage to explore other avenues for possible collaboration where expertise exists and can be mentored by either or both of them.

Objectives:

- a) To promote and enhance academic interest between KRMU and AACP to provide advice for implementation of quality education at AACP and KRMU and *vice versa*.


- b) To encourage bright students of KRMU for post-graduation education in all PG Departments of AACP and *vice versa*.
- c) To promote research/continuing educational activities between both the institutions.
- d) To carry out joint industry and research activities and projects including industry training/Internship for UG & PG students.
- e) To plan and implement exchange of visiting experts for the purpose of conducting research, seminars and lectures.
- f) To carry out discussion for the exchange of facilities and equipment's for collaborative or independent research based on the policies of both entities.
- g) To exchange the scholarly information including research papers, indices to theses, books and magazines on relevant subjects and potential joint projects where possible and appropriate.
- h) To extend invitations for attending scholarly and technical meetings as well as national and international conferences.

Technical Areas of Collaboration:

- a) A Continuing Quality Improvement Programme to improve quality of teaching staff at KRMU through short-term/long-term certificate courses by AACP Faculty. Faculty/PhD/Masters students of AACP could also be sent to KRMU for necessary training and guidance.
- b) Provide academic interaction by delivering Special Lectures at KRMU on topics of relevance to modern science and technology and *vice versa* either online or offline.
- c) Provide necessary help in Organizing Workshops/conferences and Personality Development Programmes at AACP for enhancement of skills in respect of Faculty, Staff and Students of KRMU and *vice versa*.

Limitations of Authority:

- a) Neither party has authority for an on behalf of the other except as provided in this MoU. No other authority, power, partnerships, use of rights are granted or implied.
- b) This MoU represents the entire Agreement by and between the parties and supersedes any previous letters, understanding or oral agreements between the KRMU and AACP. Any representations, promises or guarantees made but not stated in body of this agreement are null and void and of no effect.

- c) Neither party may make, revise, alter or otherwise diverge from the terms, conditions or policies which are subject to this Agreement without a written amendment to this MoU.
- d) Neither party may incur any debt, obligation expense, liability or any kind against the other without the other's express written approval.

ARTICLE II: SCOPE OF THE PROGRAM

- a) AACP and KRMU will jointly identify specific fields to conduct collaborative research programs of mutual interest in project mode involving a Scientist from AACP and KRMU. In such projects, the compounds synthesized by KRMU using its resources shall be evaluated at Department of Pharmacy, AACP at its own at nominal cost for primary and/or secondary biological screening and *vice versa*. KRMU can cost its computational resources or/and services for identifying the probable leads with the available resources and equipment's by mutually decided costs. However, KRMU can use the general facilities viz. HPLC, HPTLC, UV, GC, IR etc. available at AACP for their routine requirement on nominal payment basis.
- b) AACP and KRMU may jointly submit the projects to any funding agencies for extramural funding.
- c) AACP and KRMU may recognise few faculty members from both institutions as research co-guidance or co-supervisors in certain areas of mutual interest as per UGC/AICTE/PCI or RGUHS norms.

ARTICLE III: DURATION OF THE PROGRAM


This Memorandum shall enter into force on the date of its signing by both parties and shall take effect for a period of 3 (three) years.

AMENDMENTS/MODIFICATIONS

This MoU may be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by the representatives of both institutions.

ARTICLE IV: SPECIAL PROVISIONS

- a) Both parties hereto shall do their best efforts to ensure the smooth and efficient implementation of the Program.


- b) The Principal, Al-Ameen College of Pharmacy and Dean, School of Medical and Allied Sciences, KRMU shall meet periodically, at least once in a year to review the program and modify the scope, if required.
- c) All data generated under this Program shall be kept confidential.
- d) Nothing contained herein shall constitute this a partnership or joint venture agreement or constitute either party as the partner, principal or agent of the other, this being a MoU between independent contracting entities.
- e) No amendment or modification of this MoU shall be valid unless the same is made in writing by both the parties or their authorized representatives and specifically stating the same to be an amendment of this MOU. The modifications shall be effective from the date on which they are made.
- f) This MoU may be terminated at all time by either Party by giving written notice for 30 days. Either Party shall, upon termination of this MoU or upon request of other Party, whichever is earlier, return to such other Party all and any Confidential Information.
- g) In case of any disputes, the parties shall use their best efforts to settle all matters amicably between Principal, Al-Ameen College of Pharmacy and Dean, School of Medical and Allied Sciences, KRMU. This MOU shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India. Any disputes arising under or in connection with this MOU shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Gurugram, Haryana.
- h) Management of Program is as per the discussion and directions received from both parties from time to time. The Project Research will be steered by project managers of both the Parties:




