**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR
INSTITUTIONAL COLLABORATION**

The Memorandum of Understanding is executed on September 28, 2022.

BETWEEN

Kamalini Vocational Training Centre, Badshahpur Sohna Road, Sector 49, Alipur, Haryana 122102. Kamalini is a vocational training project of the registered society, Educational and Development Initiatives (EDI) to help needy women gain livelihood skills for a thriving future for their families.

AND

K.R. Mangalam University, Sohna Road, Gurgaon - 122103 (Delhi NCR Region), a University established under Haryana Private Universities Act 2006 (Amended 08 of 2013) and under section 2(f) of UGC Act, 1956 is empowered to award degrees, as specified under section 22 of the UGC Act, 1956, through its Registrar, duly authorized to enter into and sign an MOU on behalf of K.R. Mangalam University (hereinafter referred to as KRMU) **PARTY OF THE SECOND PART.**

The expression KRMU and KAMALINI shall, mean and include the Institutions/Organizations, their successors, appointees, assignees etc.

KRMU and KAMALINI are individually referred to as "Party" and jointly as "Parties".

INTRODUCTION:

Kamalini Vocational Training Centre, Alipur, Haryana, India

Kamalini is a vocational training project of the registered society, Educational and Development Initiatives (EDI) to help needy women gain livelihood skills for a thriving future for their families. Over the years, the Kamalini project has reached to more than 3000 women in urban villages and in rural areas near Sohna for basic literacy, garment sewing, basic beautician training and computers. Some of the courses have led to external certification by the NIIT Foundation, and the centre has been recognized with ISO certification for quality in vocational training. After training, students contribute to their family income through taking up formal employment in boutiques, home-based ventures or joined to make products to sell through a production unit. Other courses offered include

Basic English and soft skills, cooking and housekeeping, digital literacy for employability and entrepreneurship. In addition, staff and volunteers run various outreach training and service initiatives to respond to the needs of the Kamalini students and their communities.

Vision: Women are the key to a thriving future for their family and community.

Mission: To empower underprivileged women to attain holistic development through encouragement, basic education and vocational skills.

AREAS OF COLLABORATION:

The following areas of cooperation have been identified under this MoU.

- (i) Faculty in expert domain will conduct workshops, activities and events which will be provided to the students as a result of collaboration.
- (ii) Stimulate and facilitate the development of collaborative and mutually beneficial programs which serve to enhance the academic standard, professional & social skills, and intellectual life of our students.
- (iii) Provide opportunities for development of new programs and curriculum for vocational training. To identify and execute new short term certificate courses as per the demand of industry.
- (iv) KRMU will provide exposure opportunities to students to develop their competency further.
- (v) Students from Kamalini Vocation Training Centre will have the opportunity to be trained at KRMU for guest lecture, fashion shows etc.
- (vi) To counsel students of Kamalini Vocation Training Centre in scaling up their businesses and commercializing their products.
- (vii) Kamalini Vocation Training Centre will provide certification to acknowledge and appreciate student's work.

The areas of cooperation may be revised by mutual consent. However, specific programs may require separate agreements detailed out and documented as annexures to this MoU.

Preamble

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is to develop academic and educational cooperation, and mutual understanding between Kamalini Vocational Training centre and K R Mangalam University (hereinafter referred to as KRMU), Haryana, represented by its duly authorized signatory, the Registrar.

The primary objective of the collaboration to promote interaction and academic partnerships between faculty and students of the two institutions through visits, workshops and studio exchange programs, carry out joint academic programs, joint supervision of doctoral, masters and undergraduate students, joint conferences held at international and national level, sharing

of academic resources through expert talks, juries, reviews, workshops etc. on a reciprocal basis. The relationship also aims at enhancing the technological, social, and cultural relations of both regions. This document presents a general framework for the collaboration. It also includes some specifically identified areas of cooperation, which may be updated from time to time.

Coordination

The provisions of this MoU will be implemented through a team of coordinators (faculty and students) appointed by the authorized signatory from both parties.

Non-discrimination

Kamalini Vocational Training Centre and KRMU agree not to discriminate any person because of age, sex, national origin, race, ancestry, color, religious creed, disability or handicap, and sexual orientation. Neither institution shall impose criteria for the exchange of faculty, staff and students that would violate the principles of non-discrimination.

Code of Conduct

Visiting student and faculty will abide by the codes of conduct of the host Institution. The parties should ensure that the faculty and students are made aware of the rules, regulations and other administrative procedures prior to the application and approval.

Intellectual Property

The intellectual laws of the Nation will be respected and adhered to by both the parties. The two parties may jointly own the results or data generated during the collaborative projects; however, the host institution will govern the protection and commercialization of data or any intellectual property created during any of the aforementioned modes of cooperation.

Non closure agreements may be encouraged between the parties to clearly state the necessary and reasonable care to be taken to protect data or information.

Financing

Under this MoU, it is understood and agreed that there is no financial obligation between the parties. However, any support will be governed by separate agreements that may be drawn up for specific activities.

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Legal Status

This document is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial cooperation and is not legally binding on any of the parties. Any disputes shall be resolved through mutual discussion.

Validity and Termination

This MoU is valid for an initial period of **Three** years and becomes effective from the date it is signed by the partners. The partnership period may be extended by mutual consent.

This agreement may be terminated:

- a. on either party giving the other party 6 months' prior written notice;
- b. on written notice by one of the Parties if the other Party has committed a breach of this MoU.





