MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

The Memorandum of Understanding is executed on 13th day of December, 2022

BETWEEN

K.R. Mangalam University, Sohna Road, Gurgaon - 122103 (Delhi NCR Region), a University established under the Haryana Private Universities Act 2006 (Amended 08 of 2013) and under section 2(f) of UGC Act, 1956 wherein empowered to award degrees, as specified under section 22 of the UGC Act, 1956, through its **Registrar** presently **Gp. Capt. Praveen Mahajan** duly authorized to enter into and sign an MoU on behalf of K.R. Mangalam University (hereinafter referred to as KRMU) **PARTY OF THE FIRST PART.**

AND

The **Sherlock Institute of Forensic Science, India Pvt. Ltd.** is an organization registered in India, with an office address at **2443, Basement, Hudson Lane, Kingsway Camp, Delhi-110009**, represented herein by its CEO, **Dr. Ranjeet Kumar Singh**, duly authorized to enter into and sign an MoU on behalf of **Sherlock Institute of Forensic Science, India** (hereinafter referred to as SIFS) **PARTY OF THE SECOND PART.**

1. SCOPE OF THIS AGREEMENT

The scope of collaboration on academic and research activities in this Memorandum of Understanding includes the following categories:

- (i) Academic and Research collaboration in the areas of mutual interest. It is expected that this collaboration will in due course lead to collaborative research projects, joint publications, joint workshops and seminars, etc.
- (ii) Scholarly information; materials and publications, Faculty development programs
- (iii) To conduct and organize Seminars and conferences in order to support the educational programs in the field of Professional Competencies (particularly the areas of Ethics, Professionalism in Forensic Science).

- (iv) To facilitate visits by students and staff to integrate enhancement, participation in research and completion of proposals and projects in the related field of Forensic Science while understanding the regulations of the agreeing institutions within the Areas of Cooperation. The expenses of the participating members from the visiting Institutions shall be decided mutually wherever feasible
- (v) For research collaboration which shall involve writing collaborative research projects for funding and consultancy works. Research collaboration may be a part of the publication authorship group
- (vi) **General Purpose** is to to establish an enduring framework for educational relations and cooperation between the two participating institutions in order to promote academic learning, training, research, and forensic consultancy works and to explore the possibility of joint academic and research ventures.
- a. **Recognize** the value of academic interchange and lively engagement in an international scholarly community by a member of academic and research institutions.
- b. **Discern** the significance and importance of collaboration in the pursuit of international cooperation and awareness by each institution's interest in and need for establishing and sustaining such cooperative ties.
- c. **Confirm** the significance of the furthering of knowledge and the creative role of international scholarly communication and collaboration in the development and dissemination of learning and research.
- (vii) **Research Collaboration**
- Faculty from both Institutions will collaborate in the joint research in disciplines of mutual interest. All such joint research activities will be governed by the terms as given below:
- a. Proposals for collaborative research work under this Memorandum will be submitted with the prior approval of the Head of each institution, or his/her nominee.
- b. MoU will lead to the co-supervision of the thesis/dissertation and research of students wherever required as per the provisions of KR Mangalam University.

- c. For any research work, infrastructure and other facilities required for academic and research purposes will be shared.
- d. Each institution will nominate one of its members as its representative in charge of the cooperative programme. Individual programme of work under this Memorandum will be jointly planned and conducted by the nominees of both parties.
- e. Procedures followed in any activity under MOU will be reviewed and approved by designated authorities of both parties.
- f. Neither K.R. Mangalam University nor SIFS will be held responsible for any liability to the party, and neither party shall be required to purchase any insurance against loss or damage to any property due to activities to which this agreement relates.
- g. Every collaboration will have its own agreement / contract which addresses issues such as IPR, funding pattern, usage policies of research facilities, disclosure of information etc.

(viii) Expert Collaboration

- (i) Pursuant to the agreement for academic exchange, K.R. Mangalam University and SIFS may invite faculty/experts to deliver guest lectures, organize FDPs and engage in joint guidance of research projects according to the terms mutually agreed by both parties.
- (ii) Participants will be subjected to the rules and regulations of the host institution.
- (iii) The scope and duration of the collaboration may be amended and/or extended through the joint agreement further with the consent and approval of both the parties.

(iv) Commencement, renewal, termination and amendment

This MoU will come into force upon affixing of the signatures of the representatives of the partner institutions and will remain in effect for one (1) year. This MoU may be renewed upon

its expiry, with the agreement of both the partner institutions. If either partner institution wishes to terminate the MoU at the end of one years, it must notify the other institution not less than two months prior to the expiry of the MoU.

This MoU or its renewal and the actions taken under it may be reviewed at any time. Modifications may be made by mutual agreement and any amendment or extension to the agreement may be formalized by the exchange of letters between the two parties.


