

Recently, it has also installed a Sewage Treatment Plant which will filter the sewage water and the clean water will then be used for irrigating the patches of Aravali adopted by us. 

9. This MoU or its renewal and the actions taken under it may be reviewed at any time. Modifications may be made by mutual agreement and any amendment or extension to the agreement may be formalized by the exchange of letters between the two parties.
