

Realizing the importance of Computer Networking in today's world, KRMU CSI Student Branch in association with Network Bulls, Gurugram organized a one-day workshop on Networking, on 30th August, 2017. Mr. Siddharth and Mr Adithya, well-experienced in different fields of networking came to teach students the basics and importance of networking. Network Bulls is Asia's Biggest Cisco training company. In the workshop, the trainers discussed about very relevant networking topics beginning with basic protocols such as FTP, HTTP etc. and the various servers-Domain Name Server, Email Server etc. They briefed the students about the Open Systems Interconnection (OSI) model, a networking framework to implement protocols in layers with controls



being passed from one layer to another. Mr. Adithya also explained the detail working of the model. The practical implementation of the network on the simulator, available by CISCO was also shown. Mr. Siddharth gave the students a live experience of the working of switches and routers and transfer of data packets between

Workshop on 'Fabrication and Working of 3D Printer'

Moreover, 3D printer improves CAD software proficiency which is a crucial aspect for engineers.

Mr. Ajay Rathi illustrated design, construction and operation of fabricated 3D printer and other related aspects of Arduino based programming and construction of G-codes for CAD models. The demonstration was assisted by Sifat Singh (ME student 2013-17 batch).

Mr. Sifat Singh started his presentation by giving an insight in to the fundamentals of 3D printing technology. Furthermore, fabricating method, materials and software involvement were elaborated in easy way.



World Pharmacist Day Celebrations




